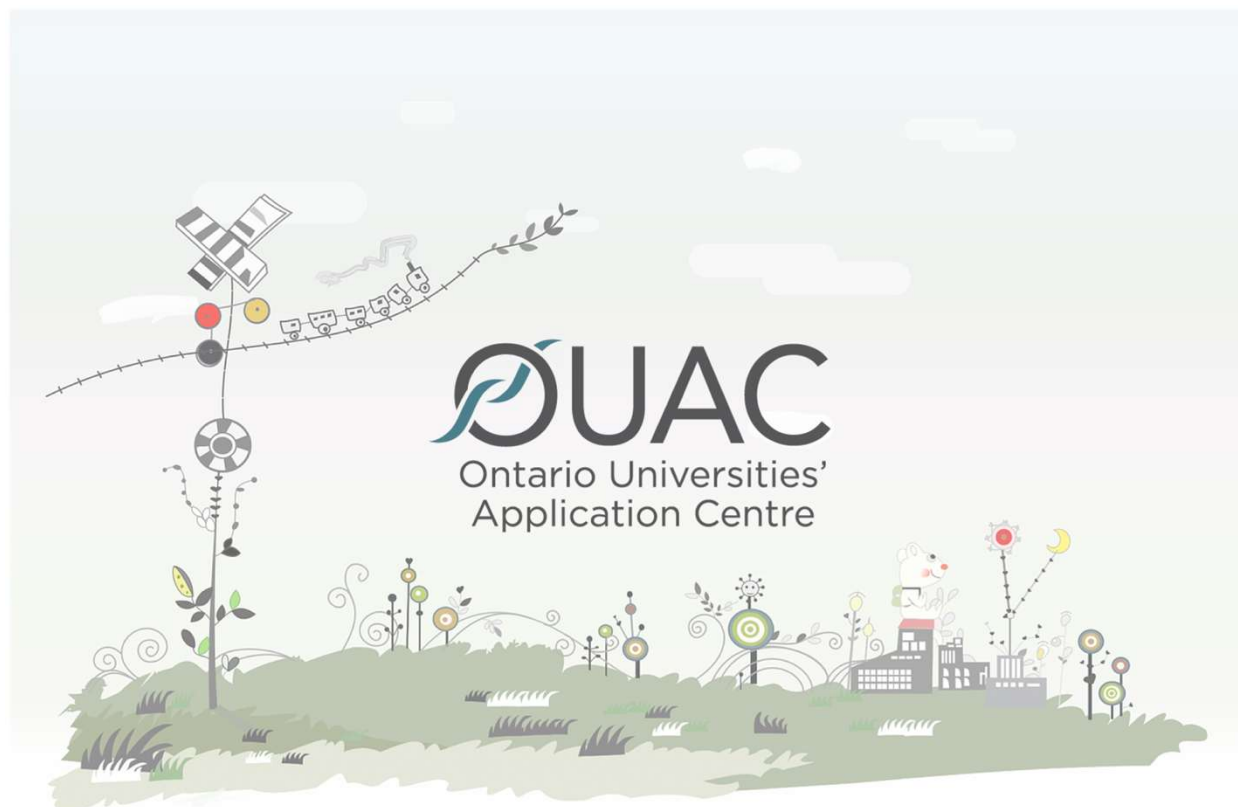
Christmas Party at school
