SAMPLE TIMELINE FOR

WITH FIRST LOOK

12 PM - Capture the finishing touches of hair and makeup for both the bride and bridesmaids. Take detail photos of stationary, the wedding dress, and other accessories. Grab a couple shots of your partner as well!

1:30 PM - First look with your partner. This moment, where it's just the two of you, is incredibly special and I always love photographing it.

1:30-3:00 PM - After the first look we will take portraits of the two of you and additional shots with the bridal party if applicable. Adjust the time frame if we need to travel to unique photo spots (I can always help you find some).

3:30 PM - The ceremony commences, with the you tucked away beforehand to maintain an element of surprise for the guests.

4 PM - Following the ceremony, seamlessly transition into family portraits, typically lasting around 20 minutes. Prior to the wedding day, I'll request a list to streamline the process. While ceremony durations can vary, I'm estimating a common time of 30 minutes.

4:30 PM - Conclude family portraits, allowing you to join your guests for cocktail hour, a bonus if you've opted for a first look. During this time, I'll capture the intricate details of the reception space you've carefully curated.

5:30 PM - The reception kicks off, typically featuring entrances, the first dance, cake cutting, speeches, dinner, and parent dances. This segment of the evening is customizable based on your preferences and is usually coordinated with the DJ.
