
Films depict the lives of two pivotal Christian Scientists who loved God and their work as practitioners, teachers, writers/lecturers.



THE HELEN WOOD BAUMAN STORY Christian Science was the answer to Helen Wood Bauman's deep desire to help humanity, and her understanding of the teachings of Mary Baker Eddy bore fruit in an extensive healing practice. She went on to become a teacher of Christian Science, and her love for communicating its healing rules and laws, coupled with her love for writing, enabled her to have over 1000 articles published in the Christian Science periodicals. Our film gives viewers an inside look at an individual who would become the

longest serving editor of the Christian Science periodicals.

THE PAUL STARK SEELEY STORY Paul Stark Seeley was one of the most beloved and respected lecturers in the history of the Christian Science movement. Graduating with a law degree from Harvard University, he left his law practice to practice Christian Science, the law of God, becoming a practitioner, teacher, and lecturer. The film documents not only his accomplishments, but also the challenges he would have to face and overcome. His story, as depicted in the film, shows how Mr. Seeley's lectures fed a spiritually hungry world with the truths of Christian Science, as revealed to, and taught by, Mary Baker Eddy.
