In 2025, our average worship attendance reached 675—a 21% increase in just two years. With the support of 522 households, we continue to advance our mission and vision of igniting hope and meaningful change for new generations.

FAITH FORMATION AND GROWTH

We celebrated 29 baptisms and grew together through 42 small groups, connecting 410 participants. We welcomed 109 new faces through first-time connection cards, and our community workshops engaged 166 individuals eager to deepen their faith and participate in meaningful conversations.

IMPACT


INSPIRING HOPE AND BELONGING


INVEST
