Will my child get personal attention?

Of course.

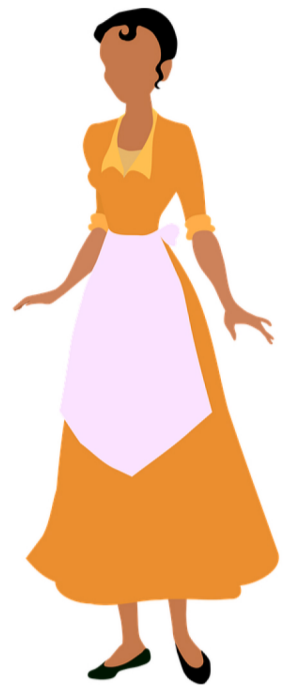
Every student will have the opportunity to learn a solo, practice in front of the class and receive individualized feedback.

What is your refund policy?

Full-refund after first class. Non-refundable after second.

After the first class, if you/your child are unsatisfied or feel the class is not a good fit, we will refund 100% of your tuition. However, once your child attends the second class, you are no longer eligible for a refund.

Before the first class.
