05 / RESEARCH AND EVALUATION

Eagle researchers utilize the most rigorous scientific methods and theory to generate timely and accurate knowledge about current behavioral health issues and the effectiveness of programs designed to support mental health across the lifespan. **In a study of young children and adolescents,** we used a nationally representative sample from the National Health Interview Survey (NHIS) drawn during the 2020 pandemic to understand family resources and stressors contributing to depression and anxiety during the first year of the COVID-19 pandemic. At the opposite end of the lifespan, **we are also studying the mental health of older aged adults living in nursing homes.** We followed nursing home residents over a year and a half to evaluate whether the household-model of care resulted in better mental health trajectories for residents than more traditional nursing home environments. In our current white paper, Eagle is leading the way in **demonstrating the use of sophisticated probabilistic methods for linking data,** while protecting personally identifiable information (PII). These data linkage procedures

will be especially important to unify the nation's thousands of fragmented public health databases and make federal, state, and local government agencies more equipped to manage a future pandemic.
