1990 - Successfully moved all mailboxes from Eastside of Petaluma Hill Road to Westside so property owners no longer had to cross road in high-speed traffic to get mail.

1998 - Joined Penngrove Area Plan Advisory Committee and we defeated 6-lane Penngrove intersection proposal.

2000 - Walked door to door raising over \$40,000 to fund litigation costs for water lawsuit – fully refunded 100% all donations to everyone who supported the winning litigation.

2002 - Filed winning lawsuit against Rohnert Park over excessive groundwater pumping and subsequent basin collapsing.

2005 - Successfully defeated Land Speculator lawsuit who was attempting to overturn Court approved Settlement Agreement that led to City’s removal of rural farmland (178 acres) from

-General Plan and now protected forever from high density development.

2005 - Guest Speaker at California Governor's Office presenting groundwater depletion in Sonoma County & related winning lawsuit

2005 - Guest Speaker at U.C Davis presenting groundwater depletion in Sonoma County & related winning lawsuit.

2006 - Worked with County Public Works Department to place speed bumps on Davis Lane and Dutch lane to slow down and discourage commute traffic bypass on Penngrove's back roads.

2003 /2008 - Worked on Sonoma County General Plan Update from 2003 to its completion in 2008 and contributed lawfully binding language for adoption to address Groundwater sustainability, Agricultural land use, Traffic Circulation, and housing. Personally hired and paid for Attorney oversight.

2012 - Called for the application paperwork to sign and endorse the first woman member of the Penngrove Social Firemen and paid the \$50 membership fee for Kim Hanson.

2009 - Worked to defeat project that included night time sports field complex located at the corner of Roberts Road in rural Penngrove.
