





# MY WEBSITE?




You can edit your theme to customize your online store's content, layout, typography, and colors. Each theme provides sections and settings that allow you to change the look and feel of your store without editing any code. [Go Here for a how-to.](#)

## TIPS

When adding text to your site, follow these best practices:

- If you're pasting text from another source, paste it as plain text. This action removes formatting that can interfere with how your text displays. For preparing text outside of Shopify, consider using a plain text editor such as Notepad for Windows or TextEdit for Mac.
- To troubleshoot text you've already pasted, use the Text Toolbar to remove formatting. For more tips, visit [Fixing text formatting](#).
- Use the Text Block to add your text. Use the Style Editor to change fonts, colors, and sizes.



## *How do I change an image on my website?*

### STEP 1 - OPTIMIZE

Firstly, please optimize your images for web! In basic terms, this is making sure they are a good file size that is still clear and crisp but isn't too big (which can cause slow loading speeds for your website = not good!). Run your images through an optimizer like [TinyPNG](#) and try to get them under 500kb if possible.

### STEP 2 - CHANGE IMAGE

### STEP 3 - ADD ALT TAG (WHERE POSSIBLE)

Alt text is text associated with an image that some browsers display instead of the image. Search engines use it to identify the content of a page. Adding alt text to images is a great way to give your site an SEO boost and make it more accessible.

Alt text is also helpful for assistive screen readers or browsers with images disabled. [Find out how to add alt tags to images here](#)
