




### **NEW EXECUTIVE SOUS CHEF HEATS UP THE KITCHEN AT** THE AMARILLO CLUB

### Cabernet Sauvignon 2016


The 2016 Cabernet Sauvignon is a blend of 95% Cab Sauvignon, and 5% Petite Sirah. This blend creates the beauty and elegance typical of California Cabernet Sauvignon. The Cab Franc adds a wonderful earthiness and mid-palate spice note that is rounded out by the black and blue berries that come from the touch of Merlot. The dominant profile remains that of the Cab Sauvignon. Sourced from vines ranging around 15 years, we find that the grapes' youth and vitality lend to the strength of character, showcased by richness but not an over-extraction.
