- 1. Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and list all GAPP participating institutions you may attend.
- 2. Create a Maryland State Aid Account through the Maryland Central Aid Processing System (MDCAPS) - <u>http://mdcaps.mhec.state.md.us</u>.
- 3. Contact the financial aid office of a GAPP participating institution and complete the application, if applicable, for a matching GAPP award.

How to Apply

Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Create a Maryland State Aid Account through the Maryland Central Aid Processing System (MSFAA). Contact the financial aid office of the GAPP participating institution.

Award Amount

For the 2023-2024 academic year, the maximum annual Maryland Guaranteed Access (GA) grant is \$20,700. So, a student who is eligible for a maximum GA grant award of \$20,700 and a matching \$20,700 GAPP grant award would receive \$41,400 annually. Students who receive a GAPP award may still receive other forms of need-based and merit-based financial aid. These funds cannot exceed the cost of attendance at the institution a student chooses to attend.



Who Can Apply

Eligible Maryland high school seniors who plan to attend a participating Maryland independent college or university as full-time, degree-seeking, undergraduate students.

Eligible Majors

All majors are eligible.

When to Apply

March 1 is the final deadline for students to submit the FAFSA or MSFAA.

March 15 is the priority deadline to submit all required documentation requested in MDCAPS.

Renewing GAPP

A GAPP award may be renewed annually for three years for students who maintain eligibility.



GAPP Eligibility Requirements

Students must meet the income eligibility requirements for the Maryland GA grant and demonstrate eligibility for institutional needbased assistance. Students must also:

- be eligible for In-State tuition;
- have an unweighted cumulative high school GPA of 2.5 or higher;
- apply to a participating Maryland independent college or university as a full-time, degree-seeking, undergraduate student; and
- be under the age of 22 at the time of receiving the first award.

GAPP Participating Institutions
