

2. Jesus wants me to know the DESTRUCTION sin brings.

3. Sin is more than just my ACTIONS.

How would things be different if people obeyed God and there was no sin? That's part of what Jesus' wanted His followers to begin to see. God's plan is good and sin utterly distorts and ruins that.

How would you answer someone who said that sin is only the wrong things we DO? Does it go deeper than our actions?
