# More Information about Camp at Triple R Ranch

Camps: Triple R Ranch offers more than one type of camp experience! See the front of the registration form for dates and prices.

**Adventure Camp:** Camp is Sunday through Friday. Check-in is Sunday at 4:30pm - 5:30pm and check-out is Friday at 5:00pm each week (Session 2 ends on

Thursday). Campers rotate through Morning Skill Area activities each morning with their cabin mates through a different schedule of skill areas each day (see Morning Skill Areas below). Afternoons are spent at the pool, playing games, more skills at optional electives (additional fees - see front of registration form), or hanging out with friends at the camp store, the "Trading Post." In the evening, all campers enjoy Bible discovery hour

and camp-wide programs that round out the day.

If you would like to add Trading Post funds at the time of registration, simply add the amount to your total payment.
