"LEARNING TO TRUST" | July 09, 2023

[CONNECT]

Share a time when you had to completely trust someone or something (a ladder, a rope, a safety harness, someone's hand, a secret). How did it feel to be vulnerable and trusting?

[ENGAGE]

What impacted you the most personally from the message?

[GROW]

Read Proverbs 3:5-6. What do each of these phrases mean and how do they connect with you personally?

- Trust in the Lord with all your heart...
- ...do not depend on your own understanding.
- Seek His will in all you do...
- ... and He will show you which path to take.

How challenging is it for you to trust God when you don't know what's happening? Read Romans 8:28. Pastor Dave used the phrase, "Nothing is Wasted." How does that change your perspective on how God is working in every circumstance?

What is the difference between working FOR Jesus, and working WITH Jesus. Read Matthew 11:28-30. What is the "easy yoke" that Jesus invites us into?

Pastor Dave shared that trust usually comes from 3 places... history, desperate circumstances, or relationship. Where does your trust in God come from?

WISE

Sometimes our trust in God is challenged by circumstances. Read these passages: Isaiah 41:10; John 10:14-15; Psalms 62:5-8. What does this tell you about our Faithful Father?

[LEAD (YOURSELF)]
