1. INTRODUCTION

1.1. Description of the ADLA E-Rate Category One Connectivity Consortium, 2026 Project

Roman Catholic Archbishop of Los Angeles, a California corporation sole, ("Archdiocese of LA") on behalf of the schools that are participants in the ADLA E-Rate Category One Connectivity Consortium, 2026 ("Consortium") has formed a consortium of elementary and high schools that are seeking bids for Internet access and transport, either via fiber or non-fiber technologies, with associated equipment that meets defined technical requirements.

The Consortium is seeking bids on:

- Leased Lit Fiber (with Internet)
- Internet Access and Transport Bundled (Non-Fiber)
- Associated Network Access Equipment

As the lead member of the Consortium, the Archdiocese of LA (ADLA) is issuing this **Request for Proposals** ("RFP") in conjunction with the submission of E-Rate Form 470 by the Consortium to request bids on Category One E-Rate eligible service. 1.2 Demographics

The Archdiocese of LA currently operates in approximately six hundred parishes, schools, and administrative locations. This RFP only includes E-Rate eligible elementary and high schools that are members of this Consortium.

1.3 General Background

1.3.1 Intent

The Consortium is soliciting proposals from qualified service providers to provide high-speed Internet services to E-Rate eligible elementary and high schools that are members of this Consortium.

1.3.2 Scope of Bids

The Consortium will consider qualified bids that incorporate all schools in the Consortium, listed in Appendix A, or any subset of schools. The Consortium may select multiple bidders for different services from bidder(s) that specify their bids can be accepted in parts.

1.3.3 Description of Services

This document is issued as a request for proposals for services at schools participating in this Consortium. See Section 2 for the scope of work.

1.4 Clarifications

Inquiries related to clarification of the RFP and RFP process must be submitted by email to phernandez@la-archdiocese.org. When a potential bidder(s) asks a question where the answer is in the RFP, the bidder(s) will be directed to which section in the RFP contains the answer. 1.5 Terms and Conditions

This is an invitation to submit a proposal based on the requirements described in this RFP. All proposals must be submitted in accordance with the specifications and requirements contained herein, as well as any addenda to this RFP if issued. This RFP is not a binding contract on the Archdiocese of LA, the Consortium, or Consortium members. The selection of one or more winning bidders is subject to the execution of mutually agreeable contracts between such bidder(s) and a participating schools.

1.5.1 Rights of the Archdiocese of LA, the Consortium, and Consortium Member Schools

Without limiting anything else herein, the rights of the Archdiocese of LA, the Consortium, and the Consortium Member Schools shall include:

- a. Subject to all applicable rules and regulations of the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC"), including E-Rate rules, and applicable policies of the Universal Service Administrative Company (collectively, "E-Rate Rules"), the Consortium reserves the right to reject any and/or all proposals for whatever reason. Subject to E-Rate Rules, nothing in this RFP shall oblige the Archdiocese of LA, the Consortium, and/or Consortium Member Schools to select one or more winning bidder(s) or to execute a contract with the winning bidder(s). The Archdiocese of LA may withdraw this RFP at any time and for any reason.
- b. Receipt of a bid proposal does not obligate the Archdiocese of LA, the Consortium, and/or Consortium Member Schools to pay any expenses incurred by the bidder(s) in preparation of the proposal or obligate these entities in any other respect.

Subject to E-Rate Rules, the Archdiocese of LA reserves the right to modify this RFP anytime during the bidding period. Any modifications will be posted at <https://c3.la-archdiocese.org/e-rate-2026>. Modifications will not trigger a new 28-day waiting period pursuant to 47 C.F.R. Section 54.622(g) unless required under the E-Rate Rules. The Archdiocese of LA will indicate whether a modification triggers a new 28-day waiting period.

- c. Any changes to this RFP must be in writing. No verbal discussions shall affect the requirements of this RFP.
- d. The award of any bids and resulting contracts with the bidder(s) are contingent upon E-Rate funding approval. Services will not be approved or provided under the said contracts until E-Rate funds are approved and committed.

1.5.2 Non-discrimination

The successful bidder(s) must comply with all applicable federal, state, and local statutes, rules, and regulations regarding non-discrimination in hiring and employment.

1.5.3 Other

- a. Archdiocese of LA approval is required for all personnel provided by the winning bidder(s) that work at or in Consortium member schools, before services are installed and commence. Proof of background checks and fingerprinting will be required and must be on file with the bidder(s) in accordance with Archdiocese of LA policies and local and state government requirements.
- b. All work at schools shall be performed outside of school hours, unless approved by the school principal and the Project Manager for the Consortium.
- c. Any planned service outages must be coordinated with the school principal, and the Project Manager for the Consortium.
- d. Any costs or charges of the winning bidder(s) which are not specifically itemized in the bidder's proposal shall not be billed to or otherwise collected from the Consortium, a Consortium Member School, or the Archdiocese of LA, without prior written notification to and approval from the Archdiocese of LA, which approval by the Archdiocese of LA may be withheld at its sole discretion.
- e. No additional compensation will be allowed for extra work incurred on the part of the winning

bidder(s) due to the bidder's failure to notice any existing conditions which may cause additional labor and costs.

1.6 Schedule of Events

The schedule below indicates the critical dates that are required for proposal consideration.

- Internet Service Contract Start Date – **Wednesday, July 1, 2026** (Contingent on E-Rate funding commitment approval. Earliest turnover start and/or actual start date will be contingent on a school's current contract expiration.)

1.7 Bidder References and Qualifications

1.7.1 References and Other Qualifications

As a reference, the bidders must submit information regarding three comparable projects that the bidder(s) has completed as the prime bidder within the last three years, preferably in K-12 school districts and/or with individual schools. The projects shall indicate the start and completion dates, services and equipment provided, project costs, contract terms, warranty, and benefits to the client schools. The bidders should provide the client's name, address, telephone number, and a contact person for each reference. The bidders must include in their proposal a complete disclosure of any alleged or actual material breach, any prior or ongoing contract failures, and any past or current civil or criminal proceedings or investigations which involves the bidder, or for which the bidder has been judged guilty or liable. Failure to comply with the terms of this provision will disqualify any proposal made by the bidder. The Consortium reserves the right to reject any proposal based upon a bidder's prior history with the Archdiocese of LA, the Consortium, and/or Consortium Member Schools, or with any other party which demonstrates, without limitation, unsatisfactory performance, adversarial or contentious demeanor, significant failure(s) to meet contract milestones, filing of liens or other proceedings, failure to pay bidders or subcontractors, and/or other contractual failures.

The bidder(s) must meet the following qualifications:

- a. The bidder(s) must have all required State Vendor/Contractor's License(s).
- b. The bidder(s) must have a USAC Service Provider Identification Number (SPIN).
- c. The bidder(s) must hold the required manufacturer certifications for the products/systems proposed in their bid.
- d. The bidder(s) must warrant the equipment necessary to deliver the Internet service to the school's headend for the entire term of the service contract.

The bidder(s) that do not meet all the qualifications in Section 1.7.1 will be disqualified and their bids will not be evaluated or included in the evaluation process.

1.7.2 Current Liability Insurance Certificate

The bidder(s) will be required to provide proof of currently active insurance, with no less than the following limits, with the Archdiocese of LA and the Consortium participating schools listed as automatically qualified as additional insureds for General and Automobile Liability:

- General Liability - \$2,000,000.00
- Automobile Liability - \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence
- Workers Compensation - \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence

1.8 Evaluation Criteria

The Consortium will select the most cost-effective service offering(s) of one or more bidders (to the extent bidders permit partial acceptance of proposals) and will use an E-Rate compliant “bid evaluation matrix” to evaluate proposals as described below. As set forth below, the matrix will include relevant factors other than the pre-discount prices submitted by bidders, but the price of E-Rate eligible products and services will be the primary factor considered.

1.9. Bid Preparation and Submission

Any services provided by this RFP are contingent upon E-Rate funding approval. The bidder(s) must be eligible and qualified to participate as a service provider in the E-Rate program and must meet all requirements of the E-Rate Rules.

- a. **Notice to the Bidder(s):** Contracts will be awarded by individual participating schools in the Consortium. This RFP is a service to aid the participating schools in securing Internet service contracts. While the Consortium, with the Archdiocese of LA as the lead Consortium member, has filed an FCC Form 470, each participating school will file a Form 471 and will serve as a **billed entity** for the services rendered to that participating school.

Prospective bidders must direct and confine all inquiries and communications concerning this procurement to Technical Contact via e-mail. **The last date to submit questions concerning this RFP is Friday, November 07, 2025, at 12:00PM PDT.** The Consortium encourages prospective bidders to submit any questions they may have as soon as possible. Questions should include “2026 E-Rate Internet RFP” in the e-mail subject line to ensure that the Technical Contact identifies the email as relating to this procurement. Answers to questions not answered in the RFP will be posted and made available publicly at <https://c3.la-archdiocese.org/e-rate-2026> and posted to the USAC EPC site on **Monday, November 10, 2025, by 5:00PM PDT.**

- c. Bids, including all documents comprising a proposal, must be submitted electronically by email to **Paul Hernandez: phernandez@la-archdiocese.org Paper copies will not be accepted.**

The deadline for submitting a bid is MONDAY, NOVEMBER 24, 2025, AT 5:00 PM PDT

- d. The Consortium will evaluate proposals for compliance with the requirements set forth in this RFP and may disqualify any proposal that fails to comply with said requirements. The Consortium reserves the right, in its discretion, to waive defects in any proposal. The evaluation team will evaluate proposals according to the process set forth in Section 6.
- e. **Reasons for Disqualification of Proposals** In addition to Section 1.7.1, if any of the following conditions occur, a bidder’s proposal will be disqualified from being evaluated.
 - I. A bidder’s proposal is submitted after RFP response deadline.
 - II. A bidder is on ‘Red Light Status’ with the FCC or is delinquent on a debt to a state or federal governmental agency or entity.
 - III. A bidder is not authorized to do business in California.
 - IV. A bidder has not been in business for at least 5 years, performing services and/or furnishing network equipment required in the bid.
 - V. A bidder failed to perform in accordance with the terms of one or more contracts with the Archdiocese of LA or any Consortium Member School within three (3) years of the issuance date

of this RFP.

- VI. A bidder does not have an E-Rate SPIN number.
 - VII. A bidder is unable to provide all associated network equipment and services required, unless otherwise noted in this RFP that separate contracts may be awarded for subsets of equipment and/or services.
 - VIII. A bidder does not provide the certifications in Section 6(h) in a timely manner.
- f. All bidders will receive notification of their bid status upon completion of the formal evaluation process, stating that the Evaluation Committee (as described below) recommends their bid to Consortium Member Schools, that their bid was disqualified, or that their bid was not recommended. Recommendations shall have no legal binding effect on the Consortium, Consortium participating schools, or Archdiocese of LA.
- g. All bidders must ensure that their cost proposals specifically include all applicable taxes, fees and surcharges which will be imposed or assessed by the bidder for their products and services.

2. SCOPE AND SPECIFICATIONS OF EQUIPMENT/SERVICES REQUESTED

- a. The Consortium is seeking bids for Internet service and transport delivered to the participating schools listed in Appendix A. Bids must include a per-service location breakdown of the following items (“MRC” is defined as “monthly recurring charge;” “NRC” is defined as “non-recurring or one-time charge”):
- I. The speed and transport technology offered to the service location. The speed must meet or exceed the speed requested for the location as listed in Appendix A.
 - II. MRC is the transport component of the service offered.
 - III. MRC for the Internet access component of the offered service.
 - IV. MRC, for any leased customer premises network equipment required to operate the service offered.
 - V. NRC for any required customer premises network equipment required to operate the service offered.
 - VI. NRC for all costs required to construct, install, and deliver the offered service.
 - VII. Estimated MRC for taxes, fees and other non-service charges levied.
- b. The proposed service must meet the following technical requirements:
- I. Equipment- Any network equipment required to deliver the service to a location must meet these requirements:
 - Operate on a single 120V/20A AC circuit and use a NEMA 5-15P plug set for power.
 - Operate in non-temperature-controlled indoor spaces.
 - Require no more than 4 cubic feet of space (approximately an 8RUx24” deep EIA rack volume).
 - For services providing 1Gbps or less, provide a single 802.3ab (1000Base-T, auto-negotiate enabled) electrical interface with an RJ-45 connector for service handoff to customer equipment.
 - For services providing more than 1Gbps, provide a single 802.3ae-2002 (10GBASE-SR) optical interface with an LC connector for service handoff to customer equipment.
 - Network equipment that routes traffic must support IPv4 and IPv6 address and routing standards.
 - II. Internet Access – The Internet access component of the offered service must meet these requirements:
 - Provide a static routable IPv4 address block of at least /29 size for use by customer equipment. We will provide ARIN address justification information upon request.
 - Provide, upon request, static routable IPv6 addresses and router.
 - Provide Internet access at contracted speed without data transfer limits, rate throttling, content filtering or DNS query interception.
 - Specify and maintain service level agreements (“SLA”) for uptime, packet loss, jitter, and latency consistent with the transport technology specified for each location. A global SLA that covers all bid locations is acceptable.
- c. Bids that offer more than one speed or transport technology for a location are acceptable. List speed and transport for a location as listed in Appendix A. The Consortium will consider each combination for a location in the evaluation process.

- d. Multi-year contracts will be considered. A bidder may provide bids for all or part of the Consortium participating schools listed in Appendix A.

3. E-RATE REQUIREMENTS

Without limiting anything else herein, or the requirements of the FCC/E-Rate/USAC rules, bidders submitting proposals under this RFP must agree to meet the following conditions relating to the E-Rate program and be willing to include such requirements in the bidder's contract:

- a. Bidder must agree to submit to the USAC Schools and Libraries Division ("SLD"), a completed and timely Form 473 for each E-Rate funding year as required by USAC. This form is available on the SLD's website at <https://www.usac.org/e-rate/resources/forms/> in the Service Provider Forms section.
- b. **Discounted Bills** A bidder must agree to provide discounted bills to Consortium participating member school locations which reflect only the net charges due to be paid by the member school location after E-rate discounts have been reflected (also known as the "non-discount" amount). The bidder will then invoice USAC using the Form 474 SPI form for the E-Rate discount amount. The bidder shall be solely responsible for timely filing and prosecuting invoices with USAC. A bidder understands and agrees that the Archdiocese of LA, Consortium, and participating schools will NOT be liable to the bidder, and the bidder shall have no recourse against the Archdiocese of LA, Consortium, or participating schools, for any discounted amount that the bidder submits late to USAC for payment, if USAC refuses to pay in whole or part any invoice due to late filing. Further, a bidder understands and agrees that (i) the Archdiocese of LA, Consortium, and participating schools shall not be liable to the bidder for any payment that USAC does not make to the bidder for any reason and (ii) the participating school which received the subject services will not be liable to the bidder for any payment that USAC does not make to the bidder, except if such payment was timely requested by the bidder and USAC states that it refuses payment solely due to the participating school's action or failure to act, in which case, the participating school shall not be liable to the bidder and the bidder shall have no recourse against the participating school for the amount at issue until the participating school and the bidder have collectively exhausted their administrative remedies of appeal to USAC and/or the FCC.
- c. **Reimbursement Option** Notwithstanding the foregoing, should a participating school choose to pay for any equipment or services in full (i.e., pays the E-Rate discount amount), bidder must agree to promptly cooperate and provide any information required for participating-school's E-Rate reimbursement forms submitted to USAC be processed successfully. This includes, but is not limited to, responding timely to questions that USAC may ask and/or submitting required documentation that USAC may request of the bidder.
- d. A bidder must separately itemize the cost of E-Rate eligible and ineligible products and/or services on all invoices. The bidder is responsible for determining eligibility and is responsible for any errors it makes in such determinations. To determine what items are eligible, the bidders may need to contact equipment manufacturers or USAC to determine E-Rate eligibility for products and/or services.
- e. If a bidder learns of any federal, state, or local investigation conducted by any regulatory authority or law enforcement authority that could have an adverse impact on the Consortium, or the Consortium's participating schools' ability to continue to receive the benefit of E-Rate funding, the bidder must notify the Archdiocese of LA, the Consortium Project Manager, and participating schools within 30 calendar days of learning of such investigation. Subject to E-Rate rules, the Archdiocese of LA, the Consortium, and participating schools reserve the right to cancel any agreements with such bidder or substitute an alternative service provider for the bidder without penalty, if an investigation impedes the Consortium's or participating schools' ability in any way to receive the benefit of E-Rate funding and/or receiving necessary school Internet service for the continued operation of the school.

4. CONDITIONS, CONTRACT AND BILLING

- a. The Consortium and its participating schools reserve the right to:
 - I. Amend, modify, or cancel this RFP, or do not make an award and reissue this RFP as a new procurement, subject to applicable E-Rate Rules.
 - II. Modify or add to the requirements contained in this RFP at any time after the issuance of this RFP for compliance by all providers, subject to applicable E-Rate rules.
 - III. Negotiate terms and conditions to meet requirements consistent with this RFP.

- IV. Request providers to clarify their RFP proposals.
 - V. Waive minor defects or any requirement of this RFP that has not been met by any of the bidders that submitted proposals.
- b. **Timeline for Work** The purchase of services is contingent upon E-Rate approval and will not occur unless and until a “Notice to Proceed” or “Service Order” is executed by each participating school. Consortium schools have the option to proceed without E-Rate funding.
 - c. **Lowest Corresponding Price (“LCP”)** Per E-Rate Rules, bidders must offer the LCP when submitting proposals. LCP is defined as the lowest price that a service provider charges to nonresidential customers who are similarly situated to a particular E-Rate applicant (library or school location) for similar services. See 47 C.F.R. Section 54.500(f). Service providers may request higher rates from the FCC if they can show the LCP is not compensatory. See 47 C.F.R. Section 54.511(b). There is a rebuttable presumption that rates offered within the previous 3 years are still compensatory. Promotional rates offered by a service provider for a period of more than 90 days must be included among the comparable rates upon which the LCP is determined. If a bidder is not offering LCP, it must expressly state so and the reason therefore, including whether it has received FCC approval for higher rates.
 - d. The Consortium and participating schools reserve the right to extend or abbreviate the contract period if such extension or abbreviation is necessary to make the contract term coincide with an E-Rate “program year” or an extended service end date for an E-Rate program year pursuant to a “service delivery deadline extension,” as those terms are defined by the FCC and/or USAC. The Bidder(s) shall provide new service agreements that begin no earlier than July 1st to coincide with the new E-rate program year to all participating schools with a current relationship as previously mentioned.
 - e. The bidder shall itemize, price, and invoice separately any materials and/or services that are ineligible for E-Rate funding. The bidder must include the following information on all invoices to the Consortium participating schools for E-Rate eligible equipment and/or services:
 - I. Invoice Date(s)
 - II. Service Date(s)
 - III. Detailed description of performed services and materials supplied that matches member school location's contract specifications and Form 471 descriptions of same.
 - IV. Clear, concise breakdown of amount(s) to be billed to USAC (discounted portion of eligible charges) and amount(s) to be billed to the member school location (non-discounted number of eligible charges)
 - V. Invoice on bidder's letterhead or on a bidder-generated form
 - VI. The E-Rate discount credit listed on the statement shall be the proper E-Rate discount percentage as set forth by the applicable FRN and USAC funding commitment letter (“FCDL”).

5. EVALUATION PROCESS

- a. The Consortium is soliciting bids on behalf of The ADLA E-RATE CATEGORY ONE CONNECTIVITY CONSORTIUM, 2026. Contracts will be awarded by the individual member school-locations participating in the Consortium. The Archdiocese of LA will NOT award a contract on behalf of the Consortium, NOR incur any financial obligation to the bidders or the Consortium. This solicitation is a service to aid the Consortium participating schools in securing Internet service.
All member school-locations will be billed entities. While the Archdiocese of LA assists the Consortium with filing an FCC Form 470 as the Consortium lead, each participating school will file a Form 471 and serve as the billed entity.
- b. **Evaluation Criteria** As per E-Rate Rules, when the Consortium evaluates qualified bids and elects to select one or more bids, it will select the most cost-effective bids. This means that the price of eligible E-Rate products and services will be the primary factor in the evaluation, but it will not be the sole factor. There will be additional factors and weights for each factor. Bids disqualified by the terms of this RFP will not be evaluated. Proposals will be evaluated using an Evaluation Committee as appointed at the Consortium's discretion.
- c. **Customer Service and Past Performance** The award decision is made based on multiple factors, including the evaluated technical merit of the bidder's proposal; a bidder's past performance in other E-Rate projects; and the evaluated probability of performing the requirements stated in this RFP solicitation, on time, with high quality, and in a manner that accomplishes the stated business objectives and maintains industry standards

compliance.

- d. **Other Factors** While the evaluation criteria rank the price of eligible goods and services highest, the Consortium has strong interest in bidders that can provide free or low-cost bundled services that address the specific needs of the Consortium school locations, such as the following:
 - I. Flexible rates based on usage (e.g., 95th percentile billing)
 - II. Local Support
 - III. Security (e.g., DDoS) protections and consulting
- e. Unless otherwise specified by the bidder in its proposal, the Consortium reserves the right to accept any item or group of items on a multi-item proposal and to accept multiple bidders for different items. Upon selection of winning bidder(s) by the Consortium, the Archdiocese of LA Legal Department will contact said bidder(s) to negotiate a mutually acceptable written contractual agreement on behalf of the Consortium and Consortium member schools.

6. INFORMATION TO BE INCLUDED IN PROPOSAL

In addition to the other information required to be provided as stated herein, each bidder will include the following with its proposal:

- a. A description of its firm's previous and ongoing relationship, if any, with the Archdiocese of LA or Consortium member schools.
- b. Proof that the bidder and all subcontractors are authorized to do business in California.
- c. Federal Tax ID Number, E-Rate SPIN Number, and FCC Registration Number (FRN).
- d. Contact name and contact information for person authorized to negotiate terms and conditions.
- e. Contact name and contact information to whom questions related to the proposal can be directed, with a statement certifying that this person (or his/her authorized representative) will be available from time after proposal is submitted through March 1, 2026, to assist with the completion of the Consortium and participating-schools' E-Rate applications, as requested, to the extent permitted by E-Rate rules.
- f. Copy of terms and conditions for proposed contracts, with a certification that the bidder understands the final contract is subject to negotiation and execution, and that the bidder's proposed terms and conditions will not automatically apply to the final contract.
- g. The bidder must indicate its willingness to be bound by the terms of this RFP.
- h. Bidder must certify that no court, tribunal, or government body has ruled or otherwise found that bidder violated the public bidding statutes or regulations of any U.S. state.
