ABOUT ANASTASIA

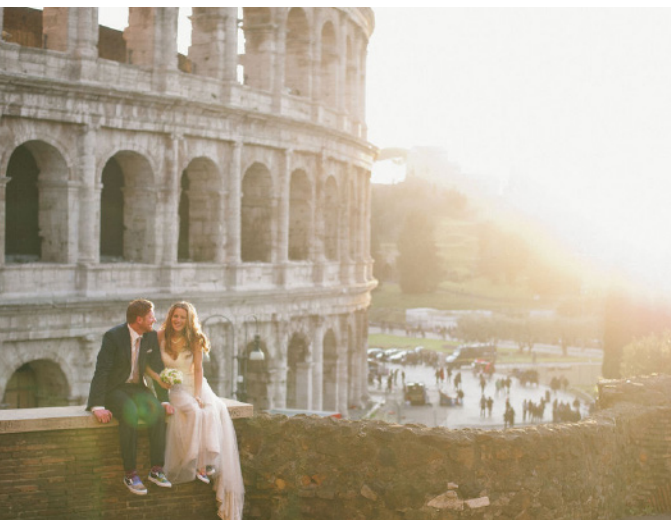
Welcome, friend.

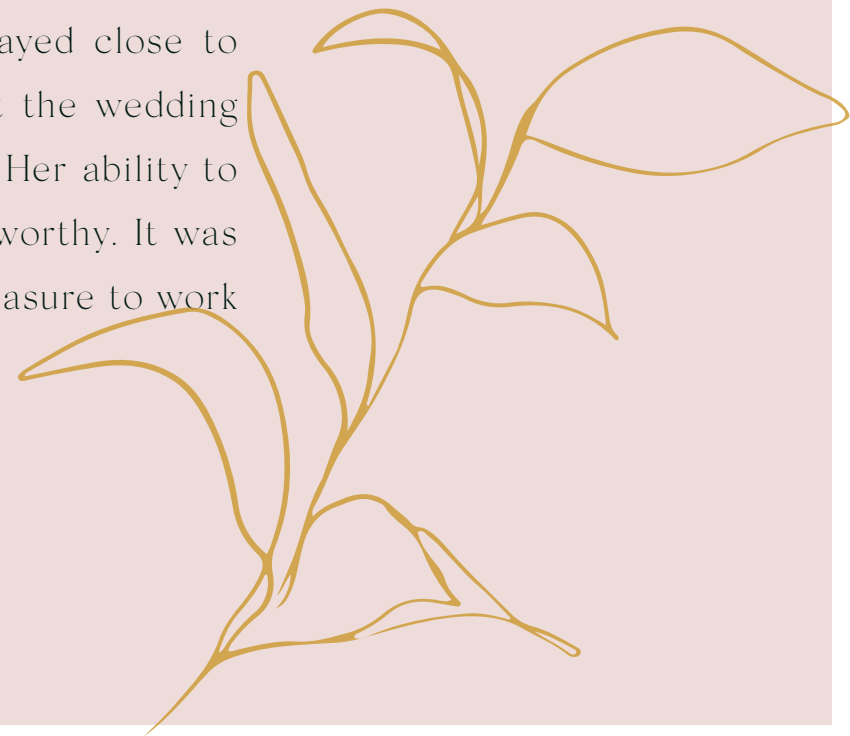
Client love

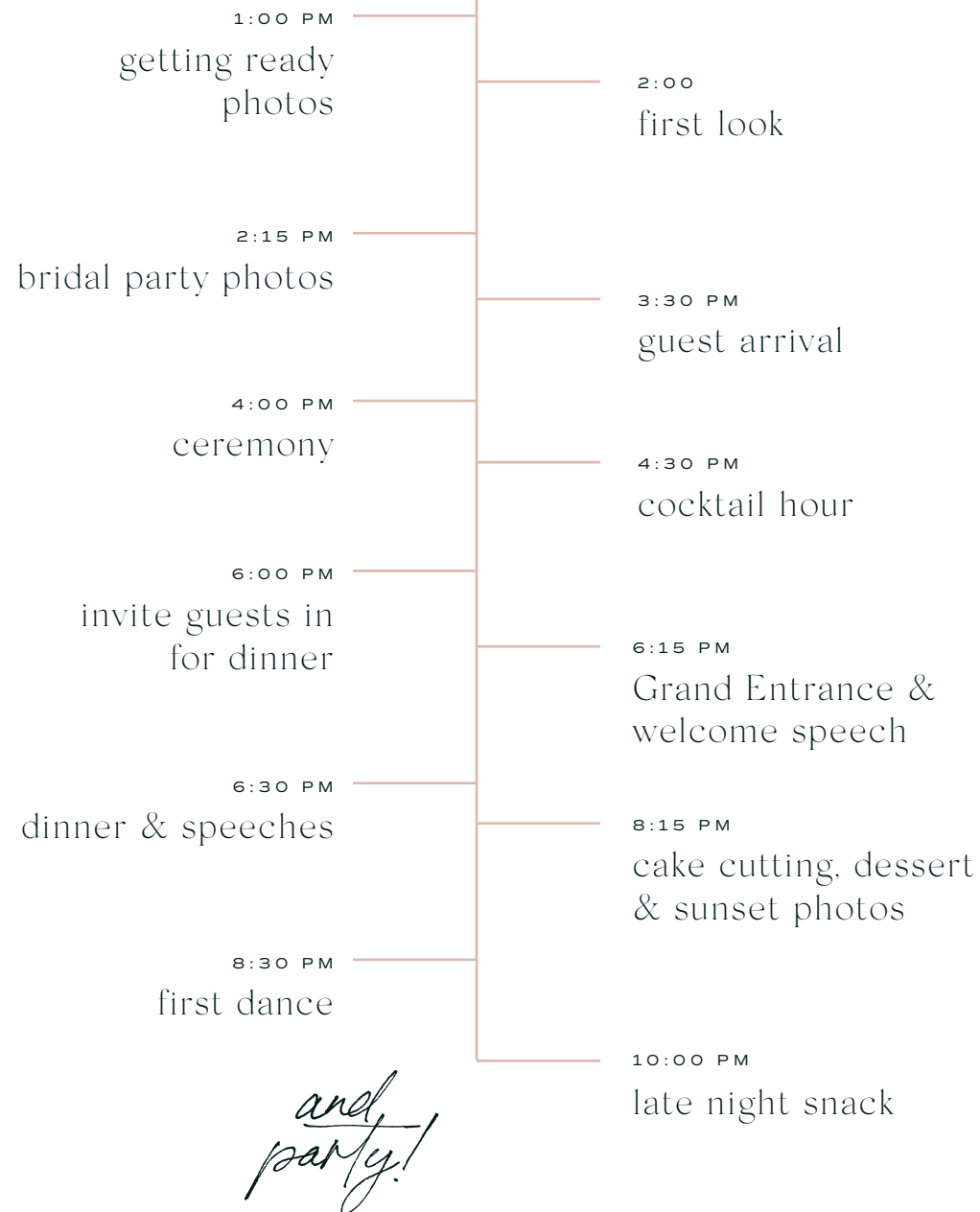
