Etta's Bin, Warroad, Minnesota

Just over 7 miles south of the Canadian border, in a part of Minnesota known as <u>Hockeytown USA</u>, <u>Etta's</u> <u>Bin</u> caters to groups or large families. The grain bin contains more than 1,700 square feet of living space and accommodates up to 10 guests; among its features are eight beds, a 12-foot kitchen island and a 6-person outdoor hot tub. The owner's grandmother, Etta, inspired the idea to convert the bin, as she loved to play hostess. Honoring Grandma Etta: Warroad grain bin turned luxury Airbnb

There is absolutely no smoking or vaping in the grain bin. Smoking is only permitted outside and all cigarette butts must be disposed and not put on the ground.

There are no parties and gatherings allowed on the property. Only guests on the reservations allowed unless okayed by the host.





During the summer months there is property maintenance that may take place such as mowing, flower beds, and watering. I do my best to have the mowing, trimming, and watering done before your arrival, but depending on the length of stay and weather please be aware to keep the property looking pristine, regular maintenance is required.

During the winter months regular plowing and shoveling will take place as snowfall accumulates keeping the walkways and parking/driveway clear for your safety and convenience.

Kitchen Facilities Included For Your Use: The kitchen has everything you will need to cook, bake, and prepare meals. Cookware, bakeware, and small appliances are located in the cupboards. The bottom pull-out drawer of the fridge houses ice and automatically keeps tray full. The water spicket is located inside the fridge on left side. Spices, salt, pepper, flour, sugar, and oil available for your use. Extra paper towels, garbage bags, cleaning products, and dish soap are located under kitchen sink



In the bins below bench you will find games, cards, dice, and poker chips for you to use and enjoy.

The thermostat on the wall left of stairs regulates the floor heat. The mini split regulates air conditioning and is run by the remote hanging on the wall by the fireplace thermostat. Propane fire place temp is set on the thermostat left of the fire place. To run fans. Make sure the switch by couch is turned on. Point the white remote on fireplace mantle to ceiling fan and push 3.

The flat screen TV streams the following: Hulu, Netflix, Disney+, Prime Video, Faith & Family, PureFlix. Enter your log in information and enjoy!

TV and ceiling fan remotes are located on the fireplace mantle in the remote organizer. The coffee and tea bar is for you to use and enjoy. Help yourself and brew a cup!



The baskets under the coffee bar have kids toys games and books for the littles to use and enjoy.

Extra sheets, blankets, and pillows along with Bath towels, hand towels, hot tub towels and sleeping cot are located in the closet by queen bed.



Bath towels, hand towels, hot tub towels and sleeping cot are located in the closet. Room darkening shades can be pulled for your privacy and comfort. 40" smart TV



The grill is a propane grill and ready to fire up and use. The prep table by the grill is for you to use as you grill up all your favorite things. When finished with grill please clean grill and replace cover when grill cools.

The wood in wood rack on the fire pit patio is for you to use. Make sure the fire is out when you're done using it. Marshmallow/Hot Dog roasting forks are located in pantry Fire Pit basket.

Shower before entering hot tub.

Make sure the cover is closed and fastened after use.

No glass in or near hot tub. No food allowed in the hot tub. Be considerate and don't spill drinks in the hot tub, and a reminder both bathrooms aren't far away!!

- Place all towels in bath tub
- Wash and put away all dishes
- Leave sheets on beds, they will be stripped by cleaning staff
- Make sure all remotes are placed back in remote organizer on fireplace mantle.
 - Make sure the lights and fireplace are turned off
 - Shut and lock all doors
 - Make sure you have all your personal belongings
- Place garbage in bin outside back door. If there is an overflow of garbage during your stay the Bin's garbage dumpster is located south of the bin.
 - Write out your postcards and address them to your special someone, they will be stamped and mailed by staff
- Please sign the guestbook sharing your thoughts of your stay and where you're from. The most important part of the Bin's story are the people who fill it!

Lake of the Woods is located 6 miles west of the property. The city of Warroad has a free access located at the point in Warroad. Directions--5 miles west on hwy II to the first stop light, take a right and follow all the way to the point.



Allison Park picnic area, pavilion and splash pad. Located on Lake Street on your way to the lake.



The Warroad Gardens & Olympic Hockey Rinks are located on the west side of Warroad. Directions—5 miles west on hwy 11 through the first set of stop lights, take a left after Holiday Gas Station all the way down on the right hand side.



The Shed, Bob Marvin's personal car collection museum is located on hwy 11 in Warroad. If the traffic light at the Shed is green it's open, if it's red it's closed. Directions--6 miles west on hwy 11 on the left side of the road.



Lake of the Woods Brewing Company brews their own beers and has tasting available.

Directions--5 miles west on hwy 11 take a right at the first set of stop lights, after train tracks take a right.



William S. Marvin Visitor Center across the highway from the Shed, check on-line for hours of operation.
