LIVE AND DIE BY THE LONGBALL: Orleans leads the CCBL with 12 HR's offensively. They are led by Kevin Sim's CCBL leading 5 bombs. The Firebirds have a record of 9-2 in games that they have hit at least 1 HR. Unfortunately, the Birds have been bit by the longball as their pitching staff, who ranks 3rd in ERA, has given up a league leading 10 HR's.

GOING STREAKING: The only teams to win 4 games in a row? The Firebirds and the Red Sox. The Firebirds have 2 stretches of at least 3 wins in a row, but they have also recorded a 4-game losing streak. These two teams meet headed in opposite directions. Yarmouth Dennis has won 3 in a row, while Orleans has hit the loss column in back-to-back nights.

KRYPTONITE? Firebirds head coach, Kelly Nicholson, has a winning record against all but one coach in the CCBL over his 17-year career as the manager in Orleans. That coach is Red Sox skipper, Scott Pickler, who has a .679-win percentage over Nicholson. The Firebirds have been eliminated from the postseason by Yarmouth Dennis on 7 occasions over the last 12 seasons.

DIAMOND HOOPS: Generally, the term "tall timbers" is used on the hardwood, but today's matchup is another one full of height. The Firebirds send out the 6'6" Donye Evans to take on the 6'4" Bryce Robison. While this doesn't compare to last week's pairing of 6'8" Bryce Warrecker against 6'10" Jake Berry, the size of the pitchers continues to pop out at you.

CHASING HOPE: Orleans fans haven't seen a postseason victory since 2019. It's been over 1,200 days since they took 1 game in a best of 3 series against Y-D. The Birds have put themselves in a good position to make a postseason run barring a second half collapse.

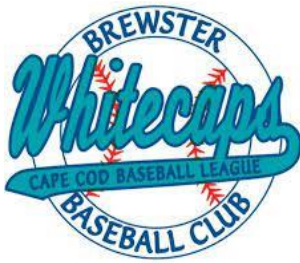
