Imagine facing frustration on your big day, struggling with unexpected situations (like weather and road closures) when all you wanted was an intimate, joyous celebration. You deserve to feel connected and celebrated, not overwhelmed and disappointed.



Here's your solution—these essential steps will help guide you through the elopement planning process effortlessly:

1- PICTURE IT. Sit down with your partner and visualize what your dream elopement might look like. Talk about what you might be wearing, what the scenery looks like, how the weather feels, what activities you might be doing, and who might be there. Now this vision can change down the road but this will help make sure you are both in agreement with how the day looks and give you a general idea of where to start.



2- RESEARCH IT. Look up general states, countries and locations that might align with what you envisioned for your day. I don't recommend getting too specific here because it can change based on a lot of things (time of year, privacy needs, willingness to hike, etc.) so just get a general idea. If you have a specific activity in mind like rock climbing, skiing, or off-roading- look up destinations that would be great for that.



3- FIND AN ELOPEMENT PHOTOGRAPHER. Finding a photographer that specializes in elopements will help make the process easy and enjoyable for you. You can search based on the area you may want to elope in, someone who specializes in the type of elopement you are looking for (destination, adventure, city, etc.), or someone who has experience with the adventure you are wanting to have on your elopement day (hiking, hot air ballooning, caving, etc.). This is one of the most important steps of your elopement planning process. Take your time researching and getting to know photographers. Make sure you vibe with them and can picture them being part of your big day. Finding someone with expertise in elopement will help streamline the rest of the planning process, create the perfect timeline, and bring your vision to life!

4-THE LOGISTICS. Now that your photographer has probably helped you narrow down the exact spot you're saying "I do", helped you find a great place to stay nearby, and has finalized your elopement day timeline- it's time to look into and book other vendors to help out with your day.
