### Pastor, How Should I Vote?

In case you haven't noticed (you must've been living in a cave), we have elections coming up this month. Occasionally, I hear someone telling others how a Christian should engage in the election process. Unfortunately, it usually ends up being a pitch for a particular party or candidate.

Why is that unfortunate? Because we're supposed to be Jesus people ... and Jesus wasn't Republican, Democrat, or Libertarian. He taught us to live a life of principles ... HIS principles. Those principles should certainly impact our voting decisions, but I see candidates with all sorts of letters behind their name who all fall on a spectrum of principles. NONE of them perfectly align with Jesus principles (just like none of US perfectly align with Jesus principles).

A Christian should first be informed about the various candidates. We're told to "love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind, and with all your strength." Church folks of yesteryear used to tell people, "don't question, just believe." But that's not what Jesus commanded. He included "all your mind" in how we're to love God.

That means we can't check our brains at the door when we come to worship, or Sunday School, or Bible Study, or anything else. So, the first thing we should know as we approach election time is that we should expect to do some research about the people asking for our votes.

Figuring out where a candidate really stands is difficult because their commercials seem to all be filled with exaggerations and half-truths. So, we should look deeper.

Paul called the Berean believers the most "noble-minded" people he spoke to [Acts 17:11]. Why? Because they received his teaching eagerly ... and then they went home and verified it with Scripture. I would encourage you to do the same with my preaching and teaching. Don't just take my word for it. I won't intentionally mislead you, but I make mistakes like everyone else. Receiving my teaching eagerly is only half the process. Go make sure I'm not full of it!

Same thing with politicians. They all talk a good game. If they have any political record ... how do they vote? Does their talk line up with their action/votes? If not, you may have found some indication of their principles. If so, does it line up with your understanding of Jesus principles?

No one said the righteous way was easy. In fact, Jesus said it would be hard. But he also told us that loving God also involves using our minds. Where can someone get information about all the candidates? I'm new to the area, so I'm looking for that, too. You can find every candidate for statewide office divided by party (because May is a Primary) at <a href="https://www.in.gov/sos/elections/files/Primary-Candidate-List-2.9.24-PM.pdf">https://www.in.gov/sos/elections/files/Primary-Candidate-List-2.9.24-PM.pdf</a>. If you don't know a candidate, check out their website. If they already hold an office, check out their record.

I wouldn't dare tell you how to vote. My ability to convince is better spent convincing you that there are no names on the ballot who can save. There's only one name by which we can be saved ... and Jesus isn't on the ballot. He can and should influence our approach to voting. But every candidate should be put in perspective of that truth. They'll never rise to His level, so the energy with which I support or oppose them should never be equal or greater than the energy I spend telling others about His saving grace!

Godspeed in your electoral decision-making, and in determining trust levels you permit any candidate.


