Guests fill out bingo cards with baby-related items, and as gifts are opened, they mark off items they predicted.



#### **Diaper Raffle**

Encourage guests to bring a pack of diapers for a chance to win a prize.



#### **Guess the Baby Food**

Blindfolded guests taste different baby foods and guess the flavours.



#### **Onesie Decorating**

Provide plain onesies, fabric markers, and stencils for guests to decorate adorable baby clothes.



# **Baby Name Suggestions**

Have guests suggest baby names, and the parents-to-be can choose their favourites.



# **Baby Predictions**

Guests write down their predictions for the baby's birthdate, weight, and gender.



# **Baby Picture Match**

Ask guests to bring baby photos of themselves, and everyone tries to match the baby pictures with the correct guest.

Sing lullabies and baby songs, with or without karaoke tracks.



#### **Baby-Themed Crossword Puzzle**

Create a crossword puzzle with baby-related clues.



# **Baby Olympics**

Set up playful baby-themed challenges, like diaper changing races or baby bottle bowling.



# **Baby Advice Cards**

Guests write down parenting advice or well wishes for the parents-to-be.



# **Baby Book Signing**

Instead of a traditional guest book, have guests sign a baby book with special messages.



# **Belly Measurement**

Guests guess the circumference of the mom-to-be's belly with a ribbon or string.



# **Parenting Tips Exchange**

Guests share their best parenting tips and tricks.



# **Baby-Themed Crafts**
