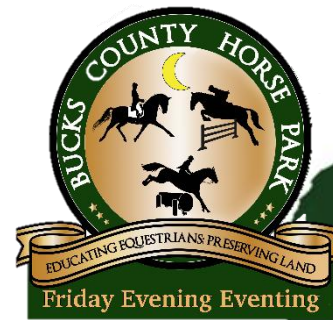


Don't forget to stamp your Passport!

Riders participating in two or more disciplines – dressage, eventing, hunter/jumpers, gymkhanas, or hunter paces – are eligible for cash prizes at the end of the year! Each competition date earns two points and each year-end award you qualify for earns five points. Ties will be broken by points earned in the hunter pace category.

Passport books are available in the secretary's stand and need to be returned to the office by November 1st.

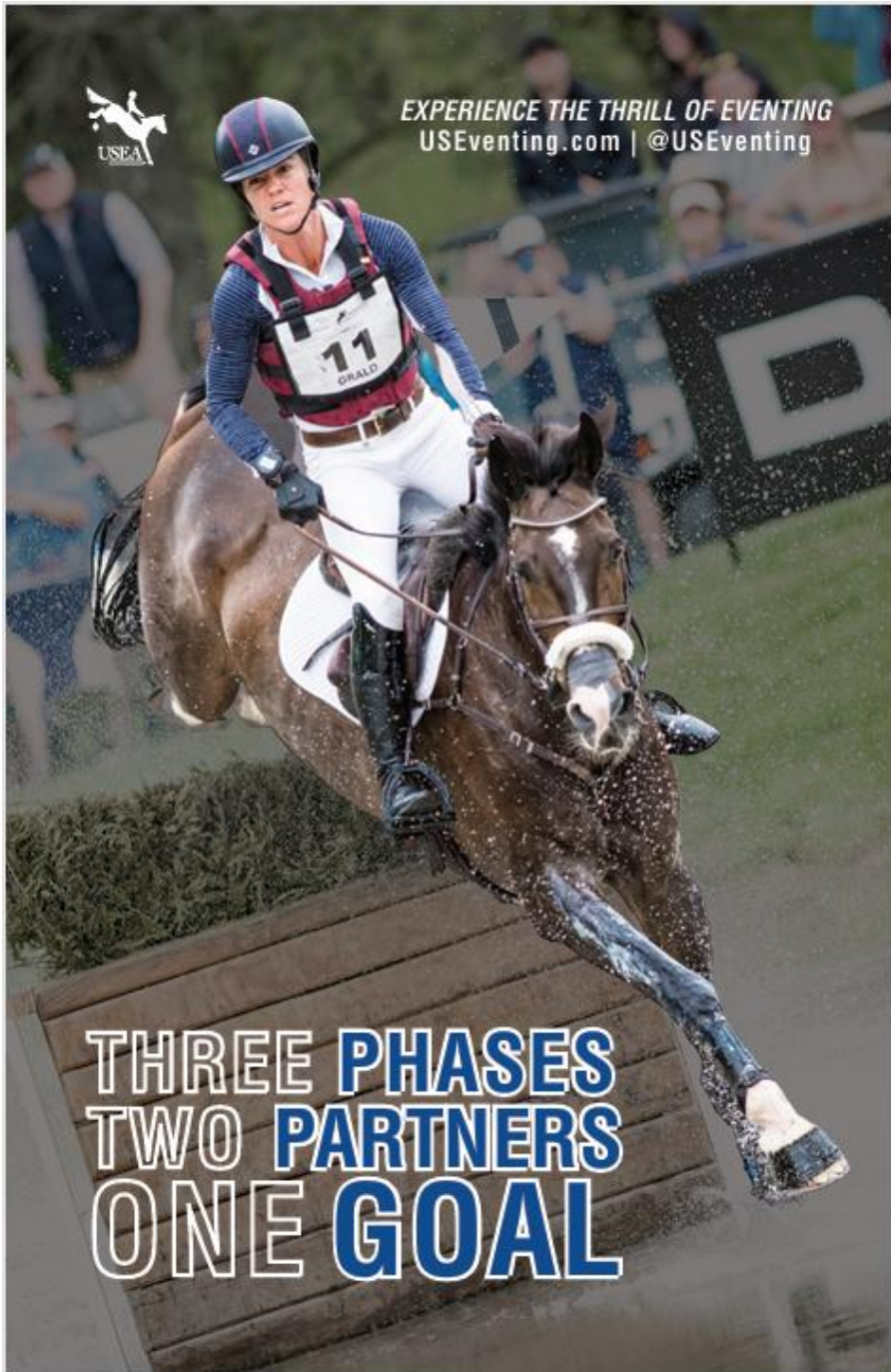
Join together with friends and celebrate together!

BCHP Members receive a \$5 discount.

REFUNDS: Before closing date, refund less \$30 office fee. After closing date, with medical excuse only, refund less \$30 office fee.

DRESSAGE ONLY - Available on any date. \$40/test non-members, \$30/test members; \$90 Fix-A-Test

CLEAR ROUND JUMPING - \$15/round scheduled at the end of each division. Limited time available. Horse and rider combinations not entered in HT/CT assessed \$20 office fee.

CROSS COUNTRY SCHOOLING - \$30/horse, BCHP members - free. Schooling allowed during CTs or following the completion of Horse Trials.

AWARDS: HT Ribbons 1st through 8th overall finish.

Dressage ribbons for scores of 35% or less.

Overall low score Thoroughbred Incentive Prog. at each show

CT Ribbons 1st through 6th overall finish.

Dressage only Ribbons given via Danish system where place is determined by score.

In-Gate Eventing November 22, 2026

Providing riders with a relaxed setting to choose between horse trials, combined tests, or dressage tests. The focus is on enjoyment and getting off the farm, rather than competition. Shows depend on the weather, and cancellations will be announced 24 hours in advance if bad conditions are expected. Cross-country fences will be set up in the large ring, while stadium fences will be placed in the adjacent ring to avoid issues with muddy or frozen cross-country tracks.

Fees: Full Horse Trial - \$70; \$30/dressage test, \$90/fix-a-test,
\$20/ XC round only, \$15/stadium round.
Refunds for pre-entries with 24-hour notice of cancellation.
No member discounts.

Times: Dressage slots on a first-come-first-served basis from 9 am to 1 pm. Pre-entry is encouraged if you would like to ride in a specific time. Dressage schedule will be posted Thursday before the show. Fix-A-Tests must be pre-entered.

If you do not pre-enter, you may jump before doing dressage.

Stadium Courses will be set as follows. Please plan on jumping in the allotted time. XC will be set and open for rounds from 9 am to 1 pm.

9:00 to 9:45	Intro	2' x-rails
9:45 - 10:45	Pre-Starter	2'
10:45 - 11:45	Starter	2'3"
12:00 - 12:45	Beginner Novice	2'7"
12:45 - 1:30	Novice	2'11"

Cross Country portable fences from the Beginner Novice, Starter, and Pre-Starter courses will be placed in the ring with heights of 2' to 2'6". Decide your course of 8 to 10 fences or do a clear round and play at will.

Each rider will have 5 minutes to ride XC fences as they wish. If weather permits courses to remain on the fields, XC will be run on the honor system as in Friday Evening.

Awards: Ribbons will be awarded to the extent possible. Riders completing a horse trial, combined test, or dressage test will be combined and placed at the conclusion of the designated stadium period.

Friday Evening Eventing Year End Award Criteria

Pre-Intro through Beginner Novice -
Horse and Rider combination must compete in a minimum of 3 shows as horse trials; not over more than two levels (higher level will be level awarded). Final year-end scores will be an average of top 3 scores achieved by the same horse and rider combination at each level.

Combined Test Level -Levels will be combined. Horse and Rider combination must compete in a minimum of 4 events. Final year-end scores will be an average of top 4 scores achieved by the same horse and rider combination.

100 pts awarded for eliminations or retirement

Each Horse and Rider combination can only win a level award in 2 consecutive years.

Eligibility Rules for Horse Trials Year-End Awards

Horse and Rider combination must attend 3 shows.
Two must be full horse trials. Final year-end scores will be an average of lowest 3 scores. If scores are obtained across multiple levels, combination will be placed with the highest level.

100 pts awarded for eliminations/retiring

Young Horse Tests will count as horse trials attendance, but scores will not be averaged in.

Combined Test Level - Open to competitors in Pre-Starter through Training/Preliminary and levels will be combined. Horse and Rider combination must compete in a minimum of 4 events. All schooling horse trials will offer a CT division if requested. Final year-end scores will be an average of top 4 scores achieved by the same horse and rider combination.

2026 Friday Evening Eventing Series

This series is designed to be straightforward and inviting. More challenging obstacles—such as banks, drops, ditches, and the water complex—are flagged with multiple options. Courses are schooling or move-up level, built below maximum height and width, and are not timed. Riders are trusted to report their faults to the starter after completing the course.

DRESSAGE ONLY rides available on any date. \$40/test Non-BCHP Member, \$30/test BCHP Member
 Fix-a-Tests must ride at assigned time, fee of \$90

CLEAR ROUND JUMPING - \$15 per round scheduled at the end of each division. Limited Time available. Horse and rider combinations not scheduled in HT/CT assessed a \$20 office fee. No cross-country schooling during the event.

Enter online at StriderPro.com *All scheduled rides will be required to submit payment, no-shows on the day of will count as a scratched entry and will be expected to pay before entering another show.*

AWARDS: Ribbons 1st thru 6th, CT Levels may be combined.

STARTING TIMES: Show starts at 2:00 pm on Friday afternoons. Levels scheduled high to low; stadium rides must be completed within window posted. XC for Pre-Introductory and Introductory available all evening.

Tentative Schedule: Sat: Young Horse Tests beginning at Noon, Dressage Ring schooling permitted before 11 am. Jumping Course acclimation permitted from 10 am to 11:30 am. Sun: Dressage-8 am; HT Show Jumping-10 am; Cross-country - to immediately follow Show Jumping. No horse may jump fences other than the designated warm-up fences prior to their test.

Awards: Ribbons 1st to 8th in each division. Dressage ribbons for scores under 35%. Thoroughbred Incentive Program Awards at each division.

Starter Membership Requirements:

Rider Membership is mandatory to accumulate year-end award points, to earn qualifications for area championships, and to earn qualifications for future USEA American Eventing Championships, otherwise optional. A limited or full horse registration is mandatory to accumulate year-end award points, to earn qualifications for area championships, and to earn qualifications for future USEA American Eventing Championships, otherwise optional.

Young Event Horse Membership Requirements:

Membership in the USEA is required for both the horse and rider at YEH qualifiers and at championships. The rider must have a full competing membership. In order to maintain complete records, all horses competing in YEH competitions must be registered with the USEA to participate in YEH classes, at least at the Limited Registration Level.
