




Rhythm, reveal, and illuminated structure

The Linea Cabinet is a vertical study in rhythm, contrast, and architectural clarity. Designed as both storage and display, the piece balances openness and enclosure through a disciplined grid of proportion, light, and material.

At 36 inches wide and rising to 66 inches high, the cabinet is divided into three vertical sections. The outer sections are composed of stacked 12-by-12-inch cubbies, each enclosed with its own door. These flanking cabinets establish a sense of order and containment, grounding the piece visually while offering discreet storage.

At the center, a contrasting column of open 12-by-12-inch cubbies introduces depth and visual intrigue. A linear LED light runs across the top of each open cubby, subtly illuminating the interior and creating a layered play of light and shadow. The interiors of these open cubbies are finished in a deep, dramatic tone, intensifying the sense of depth and drawing the eye inward.

A defining detail of the Linea Cabinet is the thin reveal that separates each door in the outer stacks. This reveal transitions seamlessly into a shelf line within the central open cubbies, creating a continuous horizontal language that unifies the three sections. The effect is both architectural and fluid—lines that shift in function while maintaining visual continuity.

Below, a six-inch toe kick angles inward from the face of the cubbies toward the back of the cabinet. This subtle recession lightens the overall mass of the piece, allowing the cabinet to appear elevated despite its vertical presence.

Composed yet expressive, the Linea Cabinet reflects Essentia's philosophy of refined simplicity. Through disciplined geometry, thoughtful illumination, and precise detailing, it becomes a piece that organizes space while quietly animating it—functional, sculptural, and deeply considered.
