It's been almost a week since we started on this journey together. It has been a roller coaster! We have heard fearful pleas from our homeless neighbors to stay open and continue to provide food for fear of going hungry, a call from a man on a bus searching for sack meals, visits from families who had missed sack lunch times at their school and needed food, and hungry UPS drivers delivering your Amazon orders who hadn't had time to stop for lunch. **We served all! With your support, we plan to continue to serve!** Through all the sack meals and supplies provided, we served 291 individual sack meals this week.

We will continue to provide daily sack meals through support from our church partners. Going forward, we plan to serve meals all hours we are open. Also, if sacks are available, we will provide two sacks on Friday to help get through the weekend.

You can continue to help by preparing sack meals, ordering through the Amazon wish list, delivering supplies, or donating money through our website so we can shop for sack supplies or food pantry items.
