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IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED, by and between the undersigned attorneys for the parties to this proceeding, that:

1. The return date of Petitioners-Plaintiffs' ("Petitioners'") Verified Petition and Complaint ("Petition") is hereby adjourned from January 12, 2026 to **May 22, 2026**.
2. Respondents-Defendants The City of New York, New York City Council and New York City Planning Commission (collectively, "City Respondents") shall file a copy of the entire administrative record on NYSCEF on or before February 11, 2026.

3. Petitioners may amend the Petition as-of-right, and file any supporting papers, including, without limitation, a memorandum of law, on NYSCEF on or before March 13, 2026. This shall constitute Petitioners' sole opportunity to amend the Petition without leave of court.

4. Defendants-Respondents ("Respondents") shall file and serve their papers in response to the Petition (or, in the event of an amendment, the Amended Petition) on NYSCEF on or before April 27, 2026.

5. Petitioners shall file and serve any reply papers in further support of the Petition (or, in the event of an amendment, the Amended Petition) on NYSCEF on or before May 21, 2026.

6. Respondents waive any and all defenses based upon service of process of the Petition and Notice of Petition.

7. This Stipulation may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which taken together shall constitute one and the same document. Facsimile and emails signatures are acceptable as originals.
