GRIZZLY CUP CHALLENGE: Clubs may enter a single team of 10 athletes. Athletes accumulate points based on podium placement.



AWARDS

INDIVIDUAL AWARDS

Provincial Levels 1-5: 1st-8th on each event and all-around.

All Other Levels: 1st-3rd on each event and all-around.

TEAM AWARDS

Teams of 3 or more athletes within the same level are entered to compete for the team awards. Please refer to the fee schedule for the team fees.

Team Awards: 1st-3rd overall per level



GRIZZIX CUP CHALLENGE

Teams and/or clubs registering 10 or more athletes across any level are automatically entered into the prestigious **Grizzly Cup Challenge**.

Each team must nominate their 10 athletes for the competition before March 19, 2026.

Team lists must be submitted to info@thegrizzlyclassic.com.

Throughout the event, the nominated 10 athletes will earn points for their team, with every session contributing to the team's overall score. At the conclusion of the competition, the team with the highest total will be crowned Grizzly Cup Champions. Their name will be engraved on the official Grizzly Cup trophy, and they'll also receive their own commemorative plaque to proudly display at their home club.

The cost to enter a team for The Challenge is \$100.00.

Points are awarded as follows:

Note: Team points will be awarded for each of the 10 nominated athletes that is on the Team. Eg. A Club with a first-place team finish that has 2 members nominated to the Grizzly Cup team would receive a total of 10 points.


WAIVERS & RELEASES

Any participants who are from outside of Alberta agree that the appropriate release forms that are set out by their own Provincial/National sporting organization have been completed, and that all participants (athletes and coaches) have appropriately registered and insured are insured to participate in this event.



TRANSPORTATION

BUS SHUTTLE

The Grizzly Classic is proud to offer athletes, coaches, and parents shuttle service between the Delta hotel and the venue for the duration of the event. First shuttle will depart in time for athletes to make the first session (times will vary per day) with the last shuttle departing the Venue 1 hour after the final session of each day. Shuttles will depart throughout the day ensuring arrival before each session. Guests of the hotel are free to use the service throughout the competition. The cost for this service is \$50 per person for the duration of the competition and is a mandatory charge if you are staying at the Delta Hotel.

Transportation for athletes, parents, and coaches can be purchased when registering in SportzSoft. This is located under the merchandise area (same area where T-Shirt sizes are selected for athletes). Guests of the Delta will be provided with wristbands upon check-in at the hotel.

Final shuttle schedules will be provided to all clubs no later than February 1, 2026.
