
O1. WELCOME

Pre-Booking Consultation

A thirty-minute zero-obligation phone call to get to know each other and tentatively plan your session.

Contract & Retainer

Make things official by signing your booking contract and paying your 50% booking retainer. The remaining 50% will be charged one week before your session.

Your Session!

This is the fun part! Come prepared to laugh, play, and make some magic.

Gallery Delivery

You'll receive several sneak peeks within 72 hours of your session. The full gallery will be delivered after 3-4 weeks!

The Party Continues

The cost of your engagement session will be credited towards any wedding package you choose to book.



"What should we wear?"

The short answer: Whatever makes you feel your best! The photos will look the best if you are comfortable and confident. When in doubt, neutrals always provide a clean, timeless look fitting for any setting. For a complete outfit guide, check out this blog post on my website.

"We're awkward in front of the camera. We'll need lots of help with posing!"

You and everyone else! Believe it or not, almost every single couple I meet with expresses this same concern. I'll guide you through your session with creative poses and gentle prompts to draw out your genuine joy and love for one another. It'll be super fun and not at all awkward - I promise!

"I'm overwhelmed by all the vendors out there. How do I know which ones are right for me?"

As a photographer and former bride, I can't tell you how much I relate to this. There is no perfect recipe, but here are some pointers:

- 1. Make sure that you see examples of what you're looking for in their portfolio. Don't trust that anyone can do anything. If needed, show them your inspiration and ask to see similar work from them.
- 2. Gauge their level of desire to work with you. If you don't feel valued by them as they should be trying to make a sale, how are they going to treat you once they already have your money?
- 3. Recognize that quality often comes at a price. Investing in a slightly more expensive vendor is, in my opinion, worth the peace of mind of knowing that the most important day of your lives is in the hands of a true expert.
- 4. Ask them what sets them apart from their competition, what the process looks like on their end, and what aspects of their business are most valued by their clients. Their answer will reveal a lot about their values as a business.

"Where do we even begin the wedding planning process?"

When you book a wedding with me, you'll receive an indepth 90-page wedding planning guide that goes into extensive detail on all things wedding planning!

For now, if you're planning on having a traditional wedding, here is a rough timeline to get you started:

- 1. Have engagement photos taken
- 2. Decide what type of wedding you want
- 3. Pick a location and venue
- 4. Lock down a date
- 5. Pick bridal party (if desired)
- 6. Pick wedding colors
- 7. Hire a planner
- 8. Go dress shopping at least 10 months in advance
- 9. Send save-the-dates 6-12 months in advance
- 10. Pick other vendors, including:
 - Photographer
 - Videographer
 - Florist
 - Hair & makeup
 - DJ
 - Caterer
 - Cake
 - Getaway car
- 11. Lock down a rehearsal location
- 12. Send invitations 3-6 months in advance
- 13. Have bridal shower, bachelor & bachelorette events

By one month out, there should be no more planning left to do. Take this time to relax, spend time with your family, and get excited!
