




### VIJAYALAKSHMI

She has a Bachelors & Masters in English Literature from Lady Shriram College, Delhi University. She is the Artistic-Director of the Centre For Mohiniyattam, New Delhi & the Founder-Director of The Mohiniyattam Institute, Los Angeles.

### OMANATHINKAL KIDAVO LULLABY SNIPPET FEATURED IN NATURALLY TAN

In the Malayalam language, there is a rich collection of traditional lullabies, known as *Tharaattu Pattu*. One of the most famous is *Omanathinkal Kidavo*, written and composed by poet lyricist Irayimman Thampi in 1813. This lullaby was written for the queen of Travancore to sing to her son young prince Swathi Thirunal, who later became the king and a famous musician. His birth was a long-awaited event for the royal family since it faced the threat of being annexed into British India under the Doctrine of Lapse for want of a male heir. The lyrics of the poem reflect this sense of relief when it refers to the baby as a 'treasure from God' and 'the fruit of the tree of fortune'. An interesting feature of this lullaby is that it doesn't mention the word sleep in it. Sleep is therefore induced by the effects of the raga. The song lends itself well to the graceful classical dance form, *Mohiniyattam*.

### SAMEER GUPTA

Sameer Gupta is known as one of the few percussionists simultaneously representing the traditions of American jazz on drumset, and Indian classical music on tabla. Sameer completed his Jazz studies learning from his peers on the bandstands in San Francisco and Oakland to Harlem and Brooklyn. His own interests and love of tabla helped guide Sameer to become a co-founder of the non-profit collective Brooklyn Raga Massive.

Today he lives in Brooklyn, NYC and is actively involved in performing, curating, producing and teaching through various institutions including the Brooklyn Conservatory of Music, Manhattan School of Music, Brooklyn Raga Massive and Carnegie Hall's Global Encounters. Sameer has had the pleasure to make music with many great musicians including 2019 NEA Jazz Master recipient Reggie Workman, Harry Belafonte, Marc Cary, Casey Benjamin, Wallace Roney, Pandit Ramesh Mishra and numerous other luminaries. From beloop to avant-garde jazz, and European classical percussion to North Indian classical tabla. Gupta continues to compose and perform music from a true multi-cultural perspective that now bridges several continents.



### **GERRY GIBBS**

Gerry Gibbs is a Grammy nominated Drummer, Producer, Band Leader, Composer & Arranger. Gibbs has released 13 albums as a leader. His first, back in 1996, Gerry Gibbs Sextet - The Thrasher featured saxophonist Ravi Coltrane with Quincy Jones as Executive Producer and his second release First Visit, with the Third Trio From The Sun, featured 7-time Grammy winning producer Greg Kurstin (producer of Adele's megahit "Hello"). More recently Gibbs released Gerry Gibbs & The Thrasher Dream Trio. We're Back and Live In Studio which featured Jazz luminaries Ron Carter & Kenny Barron. These celebrated trio recordings featured many special guests including Cassandra Wilson, and Roy Hargrove. After performing with this legendary trio, Gibbs created the Thrasher People Band with the release of the double CD Weather or Not, that featured Gibbs' acoustic jazz arrangements of Weather Report compositions as well as original material. Gerry will be releasing his next CD in August 2021. It will feature the music of his father, Terry Gibbs, featuring Gerry's 4 all star trios feat Chick Corea, Ron Carter, Kenny Barron, Buster Williams, Patrice Rushen, Stanley Clarke, Geoff Keezer and Christian McBride.

### **BOBBY WILKERSON**



Roti Prata - A South-Indian flat bread made by frying stretched dough flavored with ghee

Champagne - Universal desert/drink

Ice Kacang - A shaved ice dessert topped with rose syrup, condensed milk, red beans and cendol (green rice flour jelly)

**Kueh Lapis** - Nine-layer steamed cake made from coconut milk, tapioca flour & pandan leaves

**Kueh Tutu** - Floral shaped steamed cake filled with grated coconut cooked in gula melaka (sugar from coconut palms)

Iced Gem Biscuit - Old school biscuits with icing that originated in Britain

Medu Vada - Savory South Indian fritter made from black lentils

**Pandan Cake** - Chiffon cake with pandan leaf flavoring, giving it a lime green hue

Tanvi mentions several Singapore foods and one of her favorites is Mee Hoon Goreng (Spicy Rice Vermicelli).

Here's her exclusive gluten free, vegetarian recipe.


### INGREDIENTS

- 1 package of Brown Rice Vermicelli
- 1 Carrot, julienned
- ½ head of Cabbage, thinly chopped
- · Spring Onion Bunch, chopped
- 3 Eggs, beaten
- · 8 Shallots, chopped
- · 8 cloves of Garlic
- · 2 inch piece of Ginger
- · 6 dry Red Chilli soaked in water
- 1 cup of Water
- · 5 tbsp Cooking Oil
- 7-8 tbsp of Tamari or more

#### DIRECTIONS

- Cook vermicelli noodles according to package.
- Heat 1-2 tbsp of oil in pan.
- · Add beaten eggs. Scramble the eggs.
- Transfer to plate and set aside.
- Grind the 4 shallots, garlic, ginger, chilli to make a paste. Sadap! (Malay for yummy)
- Heat 3 tbsp oil in pan.
- Add the paste and sauté till well cooked and dry.
- · Add remaining shallots and carrots.
- Add 1 cup of water and tamari. Bring to a boil.
- · Add vermicelli and toss well.
- · Add the cabbage.
- Once the Mee Hoon is cooked, add spring onions and scrambled eggs.

Now it's MAKAN time [Singlish (Origin: Malay) for eat]. It's SHIOK [Singlish (Origin: Malay) for delicious]!


