1. Alerts:

Alerts will be given verbally to all employees from the driller or drilling supervisor. Employees on-site can also be sent a text message to relay alert information in a timely manner. The driller or drilling supervisor on-site will generate the text message to be sent to those employees on-site.

2. Extinguishers:

Portable fire extinguishers are provided in the workplace for employee use. All employees will be trained on portable fire extinguisher use and limitations. Using a fire extinguisher is not a job requirement. The employees priorities are to get off of the rig structure, evacuate to a safe distance, call 9-1-1 for help.

Fire extinguishers are located-Drillers shack Roughneck dog house Geologist trailer Tool shack Generator trailer

3. First Aid Kit:

A portable first aid kit is provided for employee use. The kit is located in the drillers shack just off of the rig floor.

4. Operations:

Any on-duty driller or drilling supervisor must shutdown any critical operation before leaving the rig floor, dog house, and/or pump area.

5. Policy:

-Fire: In the event of fire, ALL employees shall evacuate immediately. After necessary equipment is shut off or secured all employees are to evacuate the rig floor, dog houses, and pump areas.

-Explosions: In the event of explosion, ALL employees shall evacuate immediately. After necessary equipment is shut off or secured all employees are to evacuate the rig floor, dog houses, and pump areas.

-Tornado: In the event of a tornado, ALL employees shall evacuate immediately. After necessary equipment is shut off or secured all employees are to evacuate the rig premises and take cover at the nearest shelter listed above.

6. Routes:

In the event of an emergency, employees shall evacuate by means of the nearest available marked exit. All employees are to secure or shut off any equipment and exit the premises via the quickest route.

7. Duties:

Any employee is capable of providing rescue or medical assistance to another employee. The local public resources closest to the site location will perform rescue operations once they arrive on scene.

All supervisors will be trained in First Aid/CPR. These services are available, but are not a job requirement.

8. Assembly:

After an emergency evacuation, all employees are to gather behind the geologist trailer.

9. Accounting:

The on-duty driller or drilling supervisor will take a head count of all employees on-duty and make sure all employees are accounted for. Anyone not accounted for and their last known location will be relayed to the driller or drilling supervisor on-site.

10. Contact:

The driller or drilling supervisor will make contact with the needed outside agencies in the event of an emergency. In addition to the outside agencies, they will contact the company office in ElDorado, Kansas (316)322-7478 to notify the needed parties of the situation.
