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

Customized Design Proposal

Once we've gathered some initial details, we'll create a detailed proposal and estimate to present our version of your floral dream and make sure it aligns with your vision.

Revisions + Follow Up Call

After you've had a chance to review your proposal, we'll set up a call to chat through anything that needs adjusting and send you a second draft.

Contract + Deposit

Once you fall in love with the design, all that's left is to make it official! We'll lock in your date so that you can cross florals off your list!

Fine Tune + Final Payment

About 30 days before the big day, we'll touch base to chat about any final changes, double check your order, and make any necessary updates.

Delivery, Setup, + Breakdown

Our job on the wedding day goes beyond delivering your floral arrangements. We design your ceremony arch by hand, place each and every arrangement and light every candle. We make certain that every detail is perfect, including repurposing any items from ceremony to reception before we depart.







Floral Minimum

\$7,000

Premium seasonal blooms, fully custom design, and an exquisite attention to detail are the base standard when you book Magnolia Events for your wedding day. An entry level package covers personal flowers, low altar florals for your ceremony, low floral centerpieces and bud vases for most weddings up to 125 guests.

Signature Floral Design

\$12,000 +

This thoughtfully curated tier is designed for couples who desire a lush floral style including fuller altar florals, custom sweetheart or head table designs, low floral centerpieces, taper and votive candles for all tables up to 125 guests.







Premium Floral Design

All of our wedding designs come with a truly thoughtful display of elegance and detail, but for those seeking a higher level of luxury - including a statement ceremony arch, cocktail hour florals, multiple custom arrangements including entrance pieces, bar florals, cake designs, lush candle designs, or guest counts exceeding 150, we recommend a starting budget of \$20,000.

Q1. Are there any hidden fees I should expect?

Any and all fees will be included on your initial proposal, including credit card fees. The setup and delivery fees are based on a percentage of the event subtotal, so those fees may increase accordingly if upgrades or additions are made to your floral order.

Q2. How far do you travel?

We service most of North Texas, from Aubrey to Midlothian. Travel fees may apply for weddings outside of the Dallas/Fort Worth area. For destination weddings, please inquire for more information.

Q3. Do you take micro weddings?

We do take weekday micro weddings (Tues-Thurs) on a case by case basis, based on our surrounding event schedule. Any weekend event (Fri-Sun) must meet our 7k minimum. Unfortunately we do not take Monday weddings. You may inquire for your micro wedding or event as early as 2 months in advance.
