Just off the kitchen, the pantry reveals itself as a functional hub and beautifully considered extension of the home's design. A pair of two-panel doors flank each opening with custom chicken-wire detailing in the upper portion glass. This filters light between the spaces, offering a sense of openness while maintaining privacy. Inside, the pantry doubles as a compact workspace, where a built-in desk sits beneath a charming exterior window dressed in a Raoul Textiles fabric, creating a serene spot for planning, organizing, or catching up on daily tasks. Special pop-up electrical hides cording and is only visible while in use. Adjacent to the desk is a mechanical door that allows pets wearing a custom ID tad to come in and out of the house as they please. Underfoot, a custom penny-round matte glass mosaic adds a playful touch, with the word EAT laser-engraved in contrasting white glass. Though highly practical, this thoughtfully appointed room serves as a showpiece of organization and elegance...proof that even the most utilitarian spaces can be elevated with intention and artistry.
