

We exclusively source through designer-only vendors, custom workrooms, and trusted trades to create a home that feels curated and truly one-of-a-kind. To protect the integrity of your design, independent sourcing or shopping outside of our selections is not permitted, as your design is our intellectual property.

Q. Do you offer artual or remote design services

Yes we do! We hold our design presentation Thursday's via zoom and ship your sample boxes to you. Everything else unfolds just as you see here.

#### · Q: What if I need to reschedule a meeting?

We understand that life happens! Please give at least 48 hours' notice so we can adjust the schedule accordingly. We'll shift timelines as needed — but rescheduling may affect your project's overall momentum, and incur additional fees.

#### · Q: Can I add another room once we start?

If you'd like to expand the scope after we've begun, we're happy to accommodate if our calendar allows. A change order and adjusted fee schedule and timeline will be required.

#### Q: Can I source my own items or find similar options elsewhere?

To maintain cohesion and protect the integrity of the design, we do not permit sourcing outside of the The Little Green House plan. We work exclusively with to-the-trade vendors to ensure quality, customization, and availability.

#### • Q: What if my contractor suggests a change?

Any change to the design must be reviewed by us before implementation. We'll coordinate with your contractor to ensure the adjustment makes sense aesthetically, functionally, and structurally.

#### · Q: What happens if we go past the original timeline?

We do our best to keep your project on schedule. If additional design time is required beyond the scope of your package, hourly billing may apply — and we'll let you know before that happens.

#### • Q: How is project management different from design?

Design ends when you've signed off on the plan. From there, project management begins: we coordinate vendors, oversee installs, conduct site visits, and keep your project moving forward. It's billed hourly and continues until your space is complete.

## COMMUNICATION

Communication is the foundation for successful projects, and our level of communication is what sets us apart. We provide a client portal for our clients; it is a clean and easy way of communication for us. Your client portal reduces the hassle of scrolling through emails to find our communications, it houses all of our files in one place, and it maintains our scheduling, information and more. Throughout the duration of your project, we will be communicating via client portal and phone. I will be providing phone call summaries in the portal so we can keep track of all communication.
