DAIRY FARM

Dairy farms raise dairy cows for their milk. The milk is sold to dairies where it is processed and packaged.

EGG/POULTRY FARM

Egg farms raise chickens to lay eggs. Poultry farms raise chickens for their meat.

GRAIN FARM

Grain farms grow grain for making bread, cereals, and other foods. Some grains are grown for animals, too.

FRUIT FARM

Fruit farms grow apples, peaches, oranges, and other fruits for people to eat.

VEGETABLE FARM

Vegetable farms grow beans, lettuce, carrots, and other vegetables. They are sent to market and stores to be sold.

CATTLE FARM/RANCH

Beef cattle, pigs, and other animals are raised for their meat.
