



2026 Landrum Farmers Market Rules and Information

The Landrum Farmers Market (LFM) functions as a producer's market. This means that to participate as a vendor, you must grow, cook, or produce the products you sell.

1. As a vendor, you agree to allow Market Directors to visit your farm, kitchen, or craft area for inspection.
2. All vendors are required to be in compliance with state laws and permitting regulations, specifically South Carolina Law 44-1, commonly referred to as the South Carolina Cottage Food Laws.
3. The resale of produce purchased from others, yard sale items, or resale of food items is not permitted.
4. Vendors who operate and sell Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) shares are not allowed to sell or allow pickup of CSA boxes at the market.
5. Craft vendors will be limited to 20% of the total number of vendors at the market. A maximum of ten (10) craft vendors will be allowed each week.
6. At all times, farm producers take priority for space at the market. This means that craft vendors or food producers may lose their assigned space during peak market season. That doesn't guarantee a pull-in space.
7. All vendors over the age of 16 selling at the LFM are required to purchase and hold a current Landrum Business License. Licenses are valid through April of the following year.
8. All vendors selling at the LFM are required to complete a LFM Vendor Application & Certification Form.
9. Applicants will be classified as Farm Producer, Food Producer, or Crafter based on the information provided in the Application & Certification Form.
10. Vendor Radius Requirement:
To keep the market local and fresh, all vendors must operate their farm, kitchen, or production space within a 45-mile radius of the Landrum Farmers Market.
11. Dates for the 2026 Regular Market Season are Saturdays from April 4 through

October 31, rain or shine.

Winter Market dates are November 7 through December 12, excluding November 28.

12. The market will open to vendors at 7:00 AM to begin setup.

13. Customer hours for the 2026 market season will be 8:00 AM – 12:00 PM.

14. Vendor parking is on a reserved basis. Only one truck or automobile is allowed per parking space. Vendors with inside spaces may pull in to unload but must move vehicles to the designated parking area as soon as possible. Please park in the grassy field on days when no event is scheduled in the field.

15. 2026 Market Fees:

Farm Producer: \$15.00 per week

Food Producer: \$20.00 per week

Crafter: \$20.00 per week

Vendors under 16 years old: \$10.00 per week

16. Vendors who will miss a Saturday market are required to call, text, or email the Market Directors at least 24 hours in advance so the space may be filled.

17. Vendors are encouraged to stay for the full duration of the market (8:00 AM – 12:00 PM). Vendors who sell out early are not required to remain. Please pick up a “Sold Out” sign if leaving early.

18. Vendors will not be allowed to sell live animals.

19. Pets are allowed on a leash, and owners must clean up any waste. Vendors planning to bring a pet should review the full pet policy on our website at landrumfarmersmarket.com.

20. Vendors assigned pull-in spaces must provide their own tables. Electricity is available at every other pull-in spot.

21. Vendors with table spaces (35–58) will be provided one (1) 6-foot table.

22. All vendors are responsible for clean-up of their individual spaces at the end of each market day. This may include moving and storing tables, sweeping, and/or mopping.

VENDOR APPLICATION & CERTIFICATION

The Landrum Farmers Market is a producer's market. You must produce your product to participate and sell at the Landrum Farmers Market. To protect Market credibility, you must sign this application & certification form. By signing this application and certification, you understand that if your product is questioned, your farm, kitchen or workshop will be subject to inspection by members of the Landrum Farmers Market or Landrum city officials.

Based upon the products you sell at the market; how do you classify yourself as a vendor – check only one (1) box.

- ☐ FARM PRODUCER – More than 75% of the items you sell are grown by you. This includes meats, eggs, produce, plants, or flowers. Other items you sell (25%) would be baked or made by you.
- ☐ FOOD PRODUCER – You sell baked goods or food items produced by you.
- ☐ CRAFTER – You make and produce all items you sell.

VENDOR FEE STRUCTURE

Farm Producer/Legacy Vendor	\$15.00 per week
Food Producer	\$20.00 per week
Crafter	\$20.00 per week
Under 16 years old	\$10.00 per week

All vendors must also obtain and/or hold a City of Landrum Business License which is renewed annually as of April 30th. This license can be purchased at City Hall during normal working hours the third week of March- April. You must keep a copy of your Landrum Business License with you at the market for review. Cost is \$40.

PRIORITY & PARTICIPATION

In all cases, market priority is for farm producers and space will be assigned to farm producers before food producers and craft vendors. Early and later in the market season, spaces will be filled as needed with food and craft vendors. Please indicate your anticipated start date, if you plan to start any date other than the first Saturday – April 4, 2026. **START DATE:** _____
