day 1

As you drive into town stop at <u>Adventure Club</u> <u>Brewing</u> and enjoy a microbrew from **Bayfield's first brewery.** Located at <u>Howl Adventure Center</u> you can also check out bike rentals and get information about area trails.

Following check-in, take time to **soak in the view** of Lake Superior right from your room. When it's time to find dinner walk into town on **the** Brownstone Trail. <u>The Copper Trout</u> is nearby and has a charming atmosphere and delicious menu.

SUMMER

day 2

Let the sun tickle your lashes as you stroll into town to our local coffee shop, <u>Wonderstate</u>. Get your **favorite latte and fresh pastry** and enjoy them on one of the benches in Memorial Park. Bring your sunglasses as you watch the light twinkle on the waters.

Ride the ferry over to Madeline Island for the day. Within walking distance from the ferry are shops, galleries, and restaurants. The **Madeline Island Museum** boasts the area's rich history. Or bike to <u>Big Bay State Park</u> and enjoy an afternoon sunbathing on a pristine Lake Superior beach.

day 3

Mountain Biking is exploding on the Bayfield peninsula and the **nearby CAMBA trails** aim to please. With almost, 20 miles of single track, ranging from easy to difficult we can't think of a better way to break a sweat.

day 4

Bayfield is the gateway to the <u>Apostle</u> <u>Islands National Lakeshore</u> and we recommend getting up close and personal. Paddle on the clear, clean waters of Lake Superior with <u>Trek & Trail</u>. Or for those wishing for a more relaxing perspective, we recommend taking the grand tour with Apostle Islands Cruises.





day 5

Enjoy Bayfield trailside hiking among the many trails in the area. <u>The Bayfield Area</u> <u>Trails</u> wrap you in old-growth forests, brownstone cliffs, ravines, and creeks. After your hike, nothing satisfies the soul or achy legs like **hand-dipped ice cream** at one of the shops in town.

In the evening, **kick back and relax to live music** under the big blue tent at<u>Big</u> <u>Top Chautauqua.</u> Musical guests have included favorites such as Brandi Carlile, Johnny Cash, Willie Nelson, and comics including Charlie Berens.

Summer is a busy time with activities to fit any personality. We didn't even mention **picking fresh berries or sampling homemade cider, jams, and jellies** at one of the many fruit farms.

There are **gift shops, wineries, a distillery, <u>sailing</u>, and the nearby town of Cornucopia begging to be explored.**

FALL IS HARVEST TIME IN BAYFIELD

Fall is one of our favorite seasons in Bayfield. As the season changes and the pace of summer starts to slow. The changing leaves, cooler air, and changes in humidity lend to the most stunning views of all the seasons.

day 2



On day two there are definitely more trails to ride and hiking to be had. **The Meyers Beach Hiking Trail,** part of the <u>Apostle Islands National Lakeshore</u>, will give you an up-close and personal look at the mainland sea caves. Complete the evening with a **glass of wine and live music** found at <u>The Wineries on Betzold</u> <u>Road</u>.

The last of the blueberries can sometimes be picked in early September. The fall season also brings the anticipation of the area's most notable crop, apples.



day 3

The **Bayfield Apple Festival** is always the first full weekend in October. Celebrate by nibbling on a caramel apple sundae as you peruse the streets of Bayfield lined with booths of local artisans and live music coming from the street corners.

Venture out and **tour the orchards** found outside of town on the Bayfield hillside. Each has a specialty of its own from Muriel's famous apple cider donuts at <u>Erickson's Orchard</u> to Apfelhaus Ciders at <u>Hauser's Superior View Farm</u>.

Cozy Bookstores


