One round included at Corales Golf Club

Corales Golf Club is the jewel of the Punta Cana property. Designed by Tom Fazio and opened in 2010. It is set between rocky cliffs, coral reefs, and the expansive Caribbean Sea. Corales is an exclusive and dramatic golf course with six oceanside holes. The course challenges golfers of all ability levels. For those seeking a challenge, the championship black tees will stretch 7,650 yards. But don't worry, ladies, the red tees measure a comfortable 5,123 yards. This course has five color tee options to suit every golfer's needs.

Corales culminates at the Devil's Elbow, the last three golf holes. The Devil's Elbow features the striking eighteenth hole with a forced carry over the cliff-lined Bay of Corales, an inspired capstone to a memorable and breathtaking golf experience.



Two rounds of golf included at the La Cana Golf Club

The La Cana Golf Club has 27 holes of golf to choose from:

Tortuga, Hacienda, and Arrecife.

14 of 27 holes feature views of the Caribbean Sea. Designed by P.B. Dye, this club has become a favorite among golfers from around the world. La Cana strives to align with Punta Cana Resort & Club's efforts to promote environmental sustainability. La Cana has been compared to Pebble Beach and has been declared by Golf Magazine as the "number one course in the Caribbean."

One round of golf included at Punta Espada

Punta Espada is the first of 3 Jack Nicklaus Signature golf courses to be developed at Cap Cana. Opened in November 2006, it is listed as the "#1 Best Golf Course in the Caribbean and Mexico." From all points of Punta Espada, golfers have extraordinary views of the Caribbean; eight of those holes play alongside and over the ocean.

Punta Espada's vistas may make you forget about your golf game. Be sure to bring your camera for the turquoise waters, emerald fairways, and pristine greens.

For an avid golfer, no better golf experience than teeing off on the crystalline shores of the Dominican Republic in the Caribbean. With elegant resort accommodations and private villas, glorious landscapes and three championship golf courses, Punta Cana Resort and Club is the hallmark destination of choice in this golfers' paradise.

Punta Cana was founded in 1969, when thirty square miles, featuring six miles of untouched and unspoiled beaches, were available for a mere \$200,000. Forty people purchased the island. Theodore Kheel bought out the other investors in 1970 and hired Frank Rainieri, a Dominican, to help turn Punta Cana into a resort. For seven years, there was no money for the young Dominican's salary, and the Wall Street Journal even ran a cover story poking fun at the undertaking. In 1997, two new partners came on board to turn the resort into a real undertaking: Oscar de la Renta and Julio Iglesias.

Oscar's sophisticated taste was commissioned into a small, elegant hotel, Tortuga Bay, which opened in 2005. "We wanted something that would be unbelievably comfortable, that people would come back to and would tell their friends about. We want to make Tortuga Bay the most exclusive place in the Caribbean," says Oscar de la Renta from Architectural Digest.

"It was too congested," de la Renta said, talking about Casa de Campo. A place he lived for 28 years before he decided to move to Punta Cana.

Tortuga Bay is a collection of 30 suites in 13 villas strung along two miles of beach. It is a stunning, AAA Five Diamond-awarded hotel. It is also a member of Leading Hotels of the World.

It features a gourmet restaurant, an Oscar de la Renta store, reception rooms, and a gym. Most of the hotel's facilities are within a 2-to 3-minute walk, but each villa is provided with a golf cart for traveling to and from other Punta Cana resort facilities.

Oscar de la Renta's design for Tortuga Bay reflects the area's uncluttered and unhurried landscape. Kheel and Rainieri were also determined to support the Dominican economy and to protect the environment. They have set aside 1,500 acres for a nature preserve called the Ecological Reserve, featuring 15 natural spring water lagoons.



For non-golfers, Punta Cana offers the Six Senses Spa. It features expert therapists trained in Asian techniques, indoor and outdoor treatment areas, an outdoor pool, relaxation zones, steam showers, and a sauna. The package includes a 15% discount on all individual treatments from 9:00 am to 8:00 pm.

After golf, Punta Cana offers a variety of sports and recreational activities. This package includes a 10% discount on all water sports and activities at the Aquatic Center. The other activities include lighted tennis courts, horseback riding excursions, and SEGWAY Eco-Tours.



Outside the resort gates of the Punta Cana resort, a marina in Cap Cana offers fishing charters through Mike's Marina Fishing Charters. He is the longest-running outfitter in Punta Cana for offshore sport fishing, bottom fishing, and fly fishing.



The group will enjoy one night of entertainment at the popular Hard Rock Hotel and Casino. The Hard Rock has various bars and lounges as well as a nightclub. For the gambling type, there are 400 slots and games in all denominations, 40 table games, a poker room, blackjack, baccarat, craps, roulette, and a sports book. The casino is a 30-minute drive from the Punta Cana Resort property. Transportation is included in the package price.





Tortuga Bay Hotel

A member of Leading Hotels of the World and the only AAA, the room accommodation included is a Jr. Suite or a Two Bedroom Suite that overlooks the La Cana Golf Course or the Caribbean Ocean. Each suite is equipped with its own kitchen, full coralline stone bathroom with bathtub/Jacuzzi, flat screen plasma TV, walk-in closet, coffee maker, microwave, safe deposit box, private mini bar, and Wi-Fi.

The Jr. Suite offers a King-size bed, and each Two Bedroom Suite offers a queen-size bed and two full-size beds.

A full American breakfast is available at the 5 Star Bamboo Restaurant from 6:30 am until 11:00 am. Lunch is at Bamboo Restaurant, the Corales and La Cana Clubhouses, and the 28th Hole at La Cana. Dinner is included at: Bamboo, Cocco Loba, Playa Blanca, and La Yola (which is included only once during your stay, with reservations. *Service is not included)
