This year, we've seen God work in amazing ways at Good Shepherd. Your generosity, time, and invitations have made a real impact. As we reflect on all we've achieved together, we're excited to share our 2024 Impact Report, highlighting the milestones and lives touched through our ministry.

2024: A YEAR OF VIBRANT GROWTH AND MEANINGFUL CONNECTION

In 2024, Good Shepherd remained an essential resource for Kansas City, expanding faith programs and hosting impactful events like Vacation Bible School, where 296 kids and 162 volunteers shared God's love. Our outreach efforts grew stronger, providing shelter and support to 50 homeless neighbors during the bitter cold. We celebrated 29 baptisms, each a powerful testament to lives transformed by faith in Jesus, and welcomed 107 new givers, whose generosity helps fuel our mission. These milestones reflect our unwavering commitment to creating meaningful opportunities for others to deepen their faith, uplift one another, and ignite hope throughout our community.



OUTCOME

Belonging and Faith Formation:

Focused on kids, youth, and adults, accounting for 65% of spending.

We strengthened faith formation by launching Next-Gen ministries, expanding VBS, and increasing small group participation, with 38 groups and 85% of worship attendees involved.

Worship:

Worship activities accounted for 20% of the church's spending.

Our worship community grew in a big way, with attendance rising 38% in the last two years! This expansion strengthens our church and amplifies our impact throughout Kansas City.

Serving & Missions:

18% of funds went to serving the community.

We provided shelter to an average of 50 unhoused neighbors each night for a week. We support our non profit partner, A Turning Point, in an ongoing way; we pay 100% of our apportioned share of statewide and international mission work through our Annual Conference.

Seasonal Offerings:

Christmas raised: \$75,136
Easter raised: \$17,991

Christmas Eve offering supported A Turning Point; Easter funds supported NKC School Emergency Housing for unhoused children.
