The recipient will also receive the opportunity for a multi-week summer internship working with an exciting local political campaign. The selected student will be expected to fulfill the responsibilities of the internship in-person and provide their own mode of transportation.

Applications may be submitted to the BTDC scholarship committee from March 17 – April 18, 2025. All information submitted will be held in confidence and used solely for the purpose of scholarship administration.

- 1. Complete the required information.
- 2. Print or type your essays and include them with your application. The essays must be original thoughts of the applicant, in the applicant's own words, written by the applicant. Instructions appear on page four.
- 3. Provide the recommendation instructions to your Sponsor (e.g., High School Instructor, Staff, Community Representatives) as described on page five. Recommendations must be printed or typed and included with submission of the full application.
- 4. Attach a copy of your current high school transcript. This transcript must include your high school attendance record. If your transcript does not include your attendance record, please ask your school to provide an official report.
- 5. Attach an **optional** resume or cv.
- 6. Complete all information so that it is legible. Failure to do so may result in elimination.
- 7. It is suggested that you have your application reviewed by your guidance counselor, the individual writing your recommendation, or another sponsor to insure completeness and accuracy.

Completed applications must be **submitted by April 18, 2025** to the address below. Applications can also be sent as a pdf file to <u>j2aron@icloud.com</u>. Applications postmarked on April 18 will be accepted.

The candidate for this scholarship is selected based on:

- Resident of Bernards Township

- Character and leadership
- Breadth and depth of community service

APPLICANT ESSAYS

THE BTDC is interested in learning more about you, your day-to-day involvements, and your aspirations. Please answer the following prompts and carefully follow the directions for each.

On separate sheets, please prepare your essays. Include your name at the top of the pages (please use 12-point font and double space). Your signature is required at the end of each entry.

- 1. Tell us about your day-to-day in-school activities, what do you find most fulfilling? (250 words max/1 typed page)
- 2. In your day-to-day extracurricular activities (outside of school), what do you find most fulfilling? (250 words max/1 typed page)
- 3. To help us make this important decision, please tell us more, and in detail, about the following: (500 words max/2 typed pages)
 - Your interest in civics and government.
 - Aspiration to foster democratic values (life, liberty, pursuit of happiness, justice, the common good, equality, truth, diversity, and patriotism).
 - Your interest in having an internship in a local political office.

LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION

Sponsor: You have been selected by an applicant for the Bernards Township Democratic Committee Scholarship Program to provide a letter of recommendation.
