- Payment must be made at time of registration.
- All entries must be postmarked by **MONDAY - April 20, 2026** to avoid a late fee.
- A processing fee will be added on all card payments. All payments are non-refundable.
- Make entry checks payable to: West Tennessee Strawberry Festival. Mail to: Humboldt Chamber of Commerce, 1814 E Main Street, Humboldt, TN 38343.
- Parade number and position are assigned when this application and payment is received by Chamber Office.
- **All entries must be non-motorized.**
- All categories will be judged for scoring purposes, but prize eligibility is limited to the float category only.

OFFICIAL GUIDELINES

1. **This parade is non-motorized. All units must proceed without the use of motorized vehicles or equipment. Only human-powered or hand-pulled entries are permitted.**
2. Overall appearance, beauty, design, eye appeal, and originality according to thought, concept, authenticity, and thought. They are also judged on ingenuity with these ideas in mind: unusual design, moving parts, animated figures, difficult superstructure and inventiveness in costume, decoration and color.
3. Nothing will be thrown from floats or marching groups into the crowd. This is a violation of Humboldt City Ordinances! -VIOLATORS WILL BE CITED/FINED-
4. **FLOATS**
 - a "float" refers to a decorated platform that is either built directly onto a truck or trailer, or constructed separately and towed behind a vehicle.
 - There will be three (3) Humboldt winners and three (3) Out-of-Town winners.
 - Floats exceeding 15 ft. in height, measured from ground, may be disqualified.
 - Walking beside or touching floats distracts from its appearance and may affect judges scoring.
5. **DANCE/CHEER GROUPS**
 - MUST submit video recordings of parade routines for approval **PRIOR** to registration. Groups that do not provide video coverage will not be permitted to participate in the WTSF. Please send videos to festival@humboldtchamber.com.
 - All entries must be family-friendly. Content containing profanity, suggestive language, or provocative imagery will not be permitted.
 - All groups must remain in motion for the entire parade route. **Stopping at any time is not permitted, as it causes delays and disrupts parade flow.**
5. **HORSES**
 - Must wear a diaper or have someone following to clean up after the horse.
 - Horses and/or horse drawn wagon/carts will be placed at the end of the parade no matter when you register.

- EARLY ENTRY DEADLINE: **MONDAY - APRIL 20, 2026**. All entries must be postmarked by April 20, 2026 to avoid a late fee. A LATE FEE OF **\$25.00** WILL BE CHARGED AFTER THE DEADLINE THRU MAY 4, 2026. NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THE DATE - NO EXCEPTIONS!
- A processing fee will be added on all card payments. All fees are **non-refundable**.

- Parade number and position are assigned when this application and payment is received by Chamber Office.

REVUE DETAILS

- Territorial Pageants are open to all girls of appropriate age (6-9, 10-12, 13-15, 16-21) regardless of zip code, as long as they win a qualifying pageant in West Tennessee. For more information please visit our website at www.strawberryfestivaltn.com/register on what qualifies as a participating pageant.
- To enter the Miss Teen Territorial Revue, the Queen must be thirteen (13) years old and no more than fifteen (15) by May 7, 2026.
- This entry form does not enter you in the parade, only in the revue. **The parade application must be completed along with this application, photo from the night crowned, the WTSF Miss Teen Territorial Revue Contract, and the required entry fees (\$45.00 to enter Queen in revue and \$25.00 for parade application) and returned to the Chamber Office.**
- There is no official practice time but the gymnasium will open at 1:00pm on Thursday - May 7th - for anyone that wishes to practice on the stage. Drawing for your pageant number will take place once you check in the day of the pageant.
- To compete in the revue, the queen must ride in the parade (you cannot walk).
- The queen who rides in the parade must be the same queen who enters the revue. Only queens from the same revue can ride together on one float, and there can be no more than six (6) queens (entering the territorial revues) on one float.
- For any pageant who crowns multiple winners in each division - even those with different titles (Queens, Princesses, etc.) - only 2 winners per our corresponding age divisions (6/9, 10/12, 13/15) - total of 6 winners are eligible to enter the West Tennessee Strawberry Festival Territorial pageants regardless of title. If your Queen steps down or enters our revue under another title, only your 1st maid is eligible to compete.
- Participants for the Miss Teen Territorial Revue will have access to the facility **beginning at 1:00pm - NO EARLY ACCESS OR SPECIAL ARRANGEMENTS WILL BE ALLOWED.** Space will be limited to Cafeteria, Band Room, and Art Room. Pageant Chair has final discretion on where each group of participants will be staged.

Requirements

- \$75.00 clothing deposit is required to purchase wardrobes for festival week.
- Magazine pictures taken on a scheduled day with your respective court. ****MANDATORY** (no makeups allowed)**
- You will need a white gown for magazine pictures that will be taken sometime in the Fall of 2026. The gown will be worn on the WTSF float in the Junior Floats Parade on Thursday, May 6, 2027 and the Grand Floats Parade on Friday, May 7, 2027.
- Parade participation for the West Tennessee Strawberry Festival - you **MUST** ride on the Festival official floats on both Thursday and Friday.
- Queens in every court should make attendance a TOP priority for official Festival functions unless stated otherwise.

Tentative Pre-Festival Week Participation

- Christmas Parades and events in December 2026 (4-5 events).
- Humboldt City Tour with a tentative date of April 10, 2027.
- You will be asked to attend some or all of the out of town festival parades: Soybean Festival in Martin, Tennessee (usually held in September), Teapot Parade in Trenton, Tennessee (first Saturday in May) and/or the Fish Fry Festival in Paris, Tennessee (usually held the last Friday in April).

WEST TENNESSEE STRAWBERRY FESTIVAL MISS TEEN TERRITORIAL REVUE CONTRACT

As a condition of applying for my child to participate in the West Tennessee Strawberry Festival - Miss Teen Territorial Revue and in serving in the royalty, if selected, I understand and agree to the following:

1. The West Tennessee Strawberry Festival (hereinafter "WTSF") is a major community event that is important and valuable to the image, economic stability, and progress of the City of Humboldt, Gibson County, and West Tennessee as a whole, and representatives of the WTSF have certain obligations because they represent the festival to the public.
2. It is an honor and privilege to be selected as a member of the royalty for the WTSF, and that if selected as a member of the royalty, my child receives certain privileges and standing in her school and community, and that the reputation and success of the WTSF is somewhat dependent upon the acts and conduct of the royalty and representatives of the WTSF.
3. If selected as a member of the royalty, my child is expected to serve in that capacity and as a representative of the WTSF for the following year or until my successor is chosen (hereinafter "Year of Service").
4. In seeking to participate in the competition, there are requirements of the WTSF, including the rules for qualification of contestants and the guidelines set forth in this Contract that will be applicable to my child's activities during my Year of Service if selected.
5. During the Year of Service, my child's duties will include travel and participation in personal appearances on behalf of the WTSF. These activities are designed, scheduled, arranged, and supervised by the WTSF and its representatives in order to reflect the values and standards of the WTSF and to enhance its visibility and promote its purpose(s).
6. If selected as a member of the WTSF Miss Teen Territorial Royalty, participation in festival events and appearances is not only a priority, but also is mandatory unless otherwise excused in advance by the WTSF representatives.
7. The WTSF has developed procedures that govern the activities and conduct of the royalty during their Year of Service, and these procedures and standards are intended to protect and enhance the substantial public acceptance of the WTSF, and to ensure that the WTSF will continue to be able to operate for the benefit of young women who will be seeking to participate in the WTSF in future years.
8. Considering the above, and if selected as a member of the festival royalty, I will refrain from any conduct, which will result in embarrassment to the WTSF or the Miss Teen Territorial Pageant and Committee. Such conduct, which I agree would result in such embarrassment, includes but is not limited to the following: (a.) Arrest, indictment, or conviction for a crime against any municipality, state, or the United States; (b.) Public fighting or cursing; (c.) Use of alcoholic beverages or other controlled substances whether becoming intoxicated or not; (d.) Behavior that results in disciplinary action by school officials; and (e.) Pregnancy and/or marriage.
9. If I am found to have participated in any conduct or behavior described but not limited to in items a. through e., above, or similar conduct determined by the WTSF to result in embarrassment to the WTSF during my Year of Service, I shall be immediately removed as a member of the festival royalty, and I shall voluntarily surrender any title I have been awarded and return any and all awards I have received.
10. The WTSF Miss Teen Territorial Pageant and Committee has full authority to use its sole discretion in determining whether any of my future conduct is forbidden by the terms set out above.
11. Any appearances where you are asked to represent the West Tennessee Strawberry Festival, outside of your official appearances and duties, must be approved by the Managing Director and current WTSF President.
12. The WTSF's approval of my participation in the competition and, if selected, service in the royalty will be specifically based upon the representations and agreements in my Application and this Contract.
13. By signing this Contract and Agreement, I agree that all the terms are reasonable and fair under the circumstances and that if my child is selected as a member of the WTSF Miss Teen Territorial Royalty, I fully accept them and the responsibility described herein. Therefore, by signing this Application and Contract and submitting it to the WTSF for approval, I represent and agree (1) that all facts and representations contained in my child's Application, this Contract, and any attachments are true and accurate; (2) that my child and I will abide by all rules and regulations of the WTSF described in the Application, this Contract, and any attachments during the Year of Service; (3) that my child meets each requirement for eligibility to compete as set forth in my Application; and (4) that the WTSF shall have the sole discretion to determine whether, in its judgement, my child may continue to participate in the pageant and Year of Service, if selected, in the event that the WTSF determines that any statement or representation I have made is not true and accurate or that any of my child's actions is inconsistent with the rules and regulations of the WTSF and this pageant.

ONCE YOU HAVE ARRIVED ON PARADE DAY, YOUR OFFICIAL NUMBER MAY BE PICKED UP AT THE BOOTH AT THE INTERSECTION OF MAIN STREET AND 22ND AVENUE. THESE SERVE TO IDENTIFY YOUR ENTRY FOR THE JUDGES AND FOR THE MEDIA REPRESENTATIVES COVERING THE PARADE.

PLEASE ASSIST US BY BRINGING YOUR ENTRY IN THE CORRECT DIRECTION DOWN MAIN STREET IN THE STAGING AREA. ALL FLOATS WILL BE PARKED ON THE NORTH (RIGHT) SIDE OF MAIN STREET IN EVEN NUMERICAL ORDER. ALL OTHER ENTRIES WILL BE PARKED ON THE SOUTH (LEFT) SIDE OF MAIN STREET IN ODD NUMERICAL ORDER.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR FLOATS
JUNIOR FLOATS PARADE Thursday - May 7, 2026 - 10:00AM

WELCOME TO THE 88TH ANNUAL WEST TENNESSEE STRAWBERRY FESTIVAL. BELOW ARE YOUR INSTRUCTIONS AND DIRECTIONS FOR GETTING YOUR FLOAT INTO THE STAGING AREA WITH THE LEAST AMOUNT OF DIFFICULTY.

ALL FLOATS WILL LINE UP ON THE NORTH (RIGHT) SIDE OF MAIN STREET. PARADE CONTROLLERS AND/OR POLICE WILL ASSIST YOU IN PROPERLY PARKING YOUR FLOAT. PLEASE EXERCISE CAUTION WHEN DRIVING IN THE PARADE ROUTE AND IN THE STAGING AREA AS MANY PERSONS WILL BE WALKING IN THE AREA.

1. FOR NORTH BOUND FLOATS COMING INTO HUMBOLDT ON HWY 45W (FROM JACKSON), FOLLOW HWY 45 (BUSINESS) TOWARD DOWNTOWN HUMBOLDT.
2. FOR SOUTH BOUND FLOATS COMING INTO HUMBOLDT ON HWY 70-79 (FROM MILAN), TURN LEFT ON HWY 45 BY-PASS (FIRST TRAFFIC LIGHT) AND FOLLOW (THROUGH ONE MORE TRAFFIC LIGHT) TO HWY 45W (BUSINESS) AND TURN RIGHT TOWARD DOWNTOWN HUMBOLDT.
3. FOR SOUTH BOUND FLOATS COMING INTO HUMBOLDT ON HWY 45W (FROM TRENTON), TURN LEFT ON HWY 45 BY-PASS (THIRD TRAFFIC LIGHT) AND FOLLOW (THROUGH THREE TRAFFIC LIGHTS) TO HWY 45W (BUSINESS), THEN TURN RIGHT TOWARD DOWNTOWN HUMBOLDT.
4. FOR NORTH BOUND FLOATS COMING INTO HUMBOLDT ON HWY 70-79 (FROM BELLS) TURN ONTO HWY 70-79 BY-PASS AND FOLLOW (THROUGH 4 TRAFFIC LIGHTS) TO HWY 45W (BUSINESS), THEN TURN RIGHT TOWARD DOWNTOWN HUMBOLDT.

NOTE: ANY ATTEMPT TO USE ENTRY INTO THE STAGING AREA OTHER THAN THE HWY 45W (BUSINESS) ACCESS WILL RESULT IN SIGNIFICANT DELAYS.

*******IMPORTANT*******

1. THE LINEUP NUMBER YOU RECEIVE IS NOT YOUR PLACE IN THE PARADE (FOR EXAMPLE: IF YOU RECEIVE THE NUMBER 7, YOU ARE NOT GUARANTEED TO PHYSICALLY GO THROUGH THE PARADE SEVENTH IN LINE. WE DO HAVE TO FORMAT THE PARADE IN A CERTAIN ORDER).
2. ALL FLOATS SHOULD BE IN THE PARADE STAGING AREA NO LATER THAN 9:00AM ON THE MORNING OF THE PARADE. **IF YOUR FLOAT IS NOT IN PLACE BY 9:00AM YOU WILL BE DIRECTED TO THE BACK OF THE PARADE LINEUP. VEHICLES PULLING FLOATS IN TO THE STAGING AREA ARE PERMITTED BUT MUST BE GONE BY 9:30AM - THIS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.** THE PARADE WILL BEGIN PROMPTLY AT 10:00AM.
3. FLOAT RIDERS SHOULD BE MADE AWARE OF THE APPEARANCE OF THEIR FLOAT AS THEY WILL BE EXPECTED TO FIND IT IN THE STAGING AREA.
4. FLOATS WILL BE LINED UP IN THE PARADE IN THEIR ASSIGNED NUMERICAL ORDER.
5. REGISTRATION: YOU MUST PICK UP YOUR OFFICIAL NUMBER AT THE BOOTH LOCATED AT THE INTERSECTION OF MAIN STREET AND 22ND AVENUE - ATTACH FLOAT NUMBERS ON THE FRONT RIGHT AND LEFT SIDES OF YOUR FLOAT.
6. FLOATS MAY NOT EXCEED A HEIGHT OF 15 FEET MEASURED FROM THE GROUND.
7. ALL ENTRIES MUST BE HAND AND/OR ANIMAL DRAWN. PULLERS SHOULD BE AVAILABLE AT ALL TIMES IN CASE THE FLOAT MUST BE MOVED. IF ANIMAL DRAWN, SOMEONE NEEDS TO BE IN CHARGE OF THE ANIMAL AT ALL TIMES. **NO EXTRA VEHICLES WILL BE ALLOWED INTO THE STAGING AREA.** EXTRA PAPER, DECORATIONS, ETC. SHOULD BE CARRIED IN THE VEHICLE THAT BRINGS YOUR FLOAT INTO THE STAGING AREA THE MORNING OF. PLEASE BE PREPARED TO ATTACH YOUR NUMBER TO YOUR FLOAT.
8. AT THE END OF THE PARADE (12 AND MAIN) RIDERS MAY BE TAKEN FROM FLOATS. FLOATS MUST BE PULLED OUT OF THE DOWNTOWN AREA IMMEDIATELY. ALL FLOATS MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE DOWNTOWN AREA AS QUICKLY AS POSSIBLE SO THE FLOW OF THE PARADE WILL NOT BE IMPAIRED. REMEMBER THAT THERE ARE MANY UNITS IN THE PARADE AFTER YOU COMPLETE THE ROUTE.
9. **THROWING CANDY, GUM, TOKENS OR OTHER ITEMS FROM FLOATS IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED BY HUMBOLDT CITY ORDINANCE. NO ENTRY (PERFORMANCE GROUPS, ETC.) IS PERMITTED TO HOLD THE PARADE UP IN ANY WAY - THIS MEANS NO GETTING IN FORMATION, WAITING FOR MUSIC TO CUE UP, ETC. - YOU WILL BE ESCORTED FROM THE PARADE ROUTE IMMEDIATELY! THIS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED!**
10. THERE WILL BE NO GOLF CARTS, FOUR WHEELERS, THREE WHEELERS, OR ANY OTHER MOTORIZED CAR ON THE PARADE ROUTE AT ANY TIME OTHER THAN DROPPING OFF YOUR FLOAT BEFORE 9:00AM.
11. IF YOU HAVE ANOTHER OBLIGATION IN THE JUNIOR FLOATS PARADE, SUCH AS BEING IN THE BAND AND RIDING A FLOAT, IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO NOTIFY THE INDIVIDUALS AT THE REGISTRATION BOOTH OR THE JUNIOR FLATS PARADE MARSHALL THE MORNING OF THE PARADE.
