

VIBRANT AND CREATIVE


West Village is one of the most sought out neighborhoods in Detroit.

A community where intimate lot sizes allow conversations from one porch to another.


Bike the Dequindre cut or cross the bridge to Belle Isle and lie on the beach, walk the nature preserve or hit some golf balls.


THE FIRST PEWABIC TILE FIREPLACE


