Tanzania mostly uses Swahili in both official and business operations. Faraja's ability came in handy to overcome the communication barrier between our ministry team and the community in which we were ministering as she translated. We came to learn that she and her three siblings had been out of school for close to three years. Their father had lost his business and thus was unable to provide school fees for his children. They saved their shelter by a whisker.

- It was in this period that Faraja's father answered the long-delayed call into ministry and the Lord opened the door to join Yesu Akwagala Bible College and graciously provided for two years of training; and he is now back into Geita doing ministry.
- **Faraja** like her and her siblings is hoping, believing and praying to God to provide for the education for herself and her three siblings as He has provided for her father; more so as her family is unable to raise fees for their school fees.
