
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## WHAT TO EXPECT My style

# TIPS*for* your SESSION

#### Location Is Key.

This can help you determine the overall look and feel you're going for with your outfits. Nature, a white wall studio, a rooftop overlooking a downtown skyline, the beach, are all key factors to the outlook of the final product delivered. Be sure to check out my Location Guide.

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#### Mothers Choose Your Outfit First.

You want to feel confident in your photos, so find something you love and feel comfortable in first and foremost.

After, that has been accomplished balance the colors, textures with the rest of the family. Less matchy, matchy!

# *Mix Textures and Layers.*

Nothing adds depth to your portraits like textures do! If someone has a print on their shirt/dress, let them be the only one with the print.

Layer upon those colors and shades of colors from that one print. They will add interest to your photos!

Have the other family members where solid colors that correlate with that one printed shirt/dress.

#### Don't Get Too Matchy, Matchy.

Add interest by not looking all the same. Play with the textures and layers!

Blues, tans, creams and whites are my absolute timeless favorites! Loud colors like bright reds, neons, lime greens and oranges I would avoid. They will also reflect harsh color on skin tones as well as those around you.

Alternate heaviness too! If one is wearing dark colored jeans, the other may want to wear lighter colored jeans.







#### Avoid One Being Casual While The Other Is Super Dressy.

This can look off in photos. Imagine going to high end restaurant or a wedding and being fully dressed up and your partner wearing tennis shoes and shorts.

Try dressing similar - casual or dressy, but not both. If one is barefoot, everyone should be barefoot.

#### A Few Fun Things To Do.

Bring something fun to do. I'm all for a family picnic or a painting session!

#### Other Things To Avoid.

Tennis shoes, graphic tees, bold logos on shirts and baseball hats.

### Have Fun With It!

Create excitement leading up to the photoshoot about how fun everyone will have together. Photoshoots were meant to be fun, not boring is my rule of thumb. You can even excite them with going somewhere fun afterwards. like ice cream! Make the session a family date outing.









### Bring Refreshments For The Littles.

Have sippy cups, waters and snacks for their munch moments. Bring a snack or a sweet you know they will be super happy about! I'm all for rewards. They will truly be happy and thank you!

### Just A Little FYI.

The first 5-10 minutes we start is the best they will be. I will start with a group family photo first and then let them run around to get their energy out. They are always in better moods when they can escape for a bit.

#### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: What sets you apart from other photographers?

A: With a decade of training under my belt, I know how to pose and guide my clients to make them feel relaxed while looking their absolute best. I use natural light as often as possible and make sure my sessions are fun! Likewise, being a former wedding coordinator I've done weddings, maternity, families and graduates for many, many years. I have heard from countless people say I have a gift for making people feel at ease and have an eye for detail.

Q: Will we get the print release to our photos after our session?

A: Yes! Upon receiving your portraits, you will also get a full print release to your portraits. I highly recommend ordering prints through me, but it isn't required. The difference in quality is huge when it comes to ordering through a professional photographer-only printing lab, so I always love to help with prints!

#### Q: Are you willing to travel?

A: Yes, definitely! Travel fees are applied if I'm going over 60 miles, which is charged both ways. Destinations that exceed two hours driving time each way may require overnight accommodations. Please inquire.

Q: Will my photos be posted publicly on your site and/or social media?

A: Of course, I'd love to show off your portraits, if you're game!

#### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: Will you photoshop my portraits to hide any unwanted spots, wrinkles, etc?

A: Minor edits will be made to all your portraits, but I believe our imperfections are what make us beautiful and unique. If there are specific edits you want, these will be charged accordingly, depending on the type of corrections. However, I will not photoshop a client to be skinnier, taller, etc.

Q: When is your turnaround time?

A: I give a max time of 31 days. I typically deliver your gallery within one to two weeks, but give one month worth of time in case something unexpected happens to me. You will see a sneak peek within 24-48 hours!

Q: Are the people featured on your site models?

A: While I'm lucky enough to work with gorgeous clients, the majority of the images shown on my site and blog are regular, paying clients. Some photographs are from styled shoots, but mostly paid clients.

#### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: Will I receive black and white portraits in my gallery?

A: You will most definitely! I throw in a few if the quality of the portrait would look beautiful as a black and white portrait.

Q: How Do I Book A Date?

A: We can only reserve a date after receiving the booking retainer deposit, which is 50% down. We are currently booking out to December 2025. As most couples tend to have their wedding on a Saturday these are the days that book out the quickest for us.

Q: Do you prefer I order my prints and albums through you?

A: Definitely and HIGHLY recommend! I work with a professional photographer-only printing lab. They do AHH-MAZING products - from prints, albums, books, canvas', and more. A couple weeks after your wedding, I love meeting with my newlyweds to touch and look at samples of albums. You will love the end result and definitely notice it's not your typical print store quality with anything purchased through me. I've had brides want prints specifically through me months after their wedding because they did a regular print store and noticed the quality difference completely different and beautifully done.
