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Get Your Skin Wedding Ready

Flawless wedding day makeup starts with healthy, glowing skin! Here's how to prep your skin leading up to your big day:

Stick to What You Know

Start a consistent skincare routine about 3-4 months before your wedding, and avoid introducing new products or treatments in the final

month. If you're considering professional treatments, Hydrafacials are a game-changer! They deeply hydrate the skin, creating the perfect base for makeup. Try one 1-2 months before your wedding, and if your skin loves it, schedule another 2-3 days before the big day. Pairing it with dermaplaning? Total glow-up!

Hydration is Key

Your makeup will look and last so much better on hydrated skin! Aim to drink half your body weight in ounces of water daily for at least a month before your wedding.

Be Cantions with New Treatments

Always consult a dermatologist before trying invasive skincare treatments. If testing new skincare products, patch test first and give your skin plenty of time to adjust before the big day.

Thinking About a Spray Tan?

A subtle spray tan can give you a beautiful bridal glow, but I recommend skipping the face to avoid discoloration in your makeup. Instead, bring the tan up to your jawline and blend with bronzer for a seamless look. Planning to spray tan? Do a trial run before your bridal makeup trial to ensure the color works with your makeup.

Moisturize, Moisturize, Moisturize!

Keep your skin soft and supple by applying moisturizer morning and night for at least 2-3 months before your wedding. Avoid products with high alcohol content, as they can dry out your skin—remember, makeup and dry skin don't mix!

The Magic of Dermaplaning

Dermaplaning removes peach fuzz and dead skin cells, creating a smooth, flawless base for makeup. Try it 1-2 months before your wedding to see how your skin reacts. If all goes well, schedule a session 3-4 days before the big day for that airbrushed finish!

By following these steps, you'll be on your way to a healthy, radiant bridal glow. Your skin (and makeup) will thank you!

## Get Your Hair Wedding Ready

Your hair's health plays a big role in how well it styles! Here's how to prep your hair for the perfect bridal look:

Hydrate & Mourish

Just like dry skin affects makeup, dry or damaged hair doesn't hold styles as well. Frizz is often caused by dehydrationand can't be fixed overnight. Start using deep-conditioning treatments and hair masks at least 1-2 months before your wedding to restore moisture and improve texture. (Favorites: Olaplex & Amika!)

Protect Your Hair

Limit heat styling (blow drying, curling, straightening) in the months leading up to your big day, and always use a heat protectant to minimize damage and keep your hair healthy. My top picks: Kenra & Olaplex.

Clarify for Volume & Freshness

If your roots tend to get oily quickly or you want extra volume, use a clarifying shampoo in the weeks leading up to your wedding. This removes product buildup and excess oils, helping your hair feel lighter and more voluminous.

Come with Clean, Dry Hair

For both your bridal trial and wedding day, make sure your hair is completely dry and free of excess oil. Wash your hair the night before for the best results. Conditioning only the ends.

Hair Extensions

Hair extensions aren't just for adding length, they give volume, hold styles longer, and keep your hair looking flawless all day and night. Even if you have thick hair, extensions can provide extra support to maintain your curls and prevent them from falling as you dance the night away!

## Preparing for your Preview

How to Get the Most Out of Your Trial

Your bridal preview is the perfect time to refine your hair and makeup look before the big day! Here's how to prepare:

Before your Preview:

1. Gather Inspiration - Create a mood board with hair and makeup looks you love. Try to choose photos with features similar to yours (hair color, eye shape, skin tone) for a more realistic idea of how styles will look on you.

2. Bring Your Accessories - If you're wearing a veil, headpiece, or special earrings, bring them so we can incorporate them into your

look. Ensure your veil has a metal comb for better grip.

3. Wear White - A white top or dress helps you visualize how your

makeup and hair will look with your wedding gown.

4. Hydrate & Prep Your Skin - Drińk plenty of water and maintain a góod skincare routine leading up to thé trial. If getting a facial, šchedule it 2-3 weeks before to avoid irritation.

5. Wash & Prep Your Hair - Wash your hair the night before and avoid heavy conditioners or leave-in products that could weigh it down.
