- · Adding to the beauty of GPC's landscaping with blooming flowers
- · Offering to be a greeter on Sunday mornings and saying yes to becoming an usher
- · Baking hundreds of muffins to enjoy at Sunday Coffee Fellowship

The theme for this year's stewardship season is based on Philippians 3:13: Forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead.

While it is important to recognize and give thanks for what has brought us to this point, our challenge from God is to keep straining forward to the future that God is preparing for us.
