Genesis 39:2-3 (NIV)



- 3. In what ways do we unintentionally distance ourselves from God's presence, as mentioned in the message? What practical steps can you take to become more aware of and connected to God's presence in daily life?
- 4. Joshua faces a massive transition after Moses dies, yet God promised, "I will never leave you nor forsake you." (Joshua 1:5) What current transition or unknown are you facing where you need to trust in this same promise?
- 5. "His presence in my suffering allows me to encourage others in their suffering." Have you experienced this truth in your life? Who might God be calling you to come alongside and encourage today?
