- God created all things.
 - o (Isaiah 45:11-12; Psalm 33)
- Humans are created in God's image and He desires to be in relationship with us.
 - o (Genesis 1:26-27; Ephesians 5:21-23)
- All humans are born with a sin nature.
 - o (Romans 5:12; Romans 5:19)
- God has provided salvation to all who believe in His Son Jesus.
 - o (John 3:16-19; John 5:24; Ephesians 2:8-10)
- The church is one body with many members.
