16. Is Baptism only symbolic, or does it actually forgive sins? (See Acts 2:38; Acts 22:16; 1 Peter 3:20-21)
17. Who is Baptism for? (See Matthew 28:19; Acts 2:39; Psalm 51:5; Matthew 18:6)
