



Read the story of the Rich Young Ruler in Matthew 19:16-26. Try to put yourself into the story looking back and forth between Jesus and this young man as they converse. What do you see in the young man's face? What do you see in Jesus' expression. What do you think Jesus wants for him? What do you think Jesus wants for you?

How hard is it for you to be content with what you have with the constant push for more in our culture? What do you do with Paul's words in Philippians 4:11-13?

Read the full passage from 1Timothy 6:6-10. What does Paul teach about contentment and true wealth? How do we transform our thinking and perspective to find true satisfaction and contentment in Jesus? See Colossians 3:1-4

[LEAD (YOURSELF)]

Pay attention this week to your inner cravings. What is it that you want? What is it that seems lacking? Are there areas where you feel cheated or overlooked? Bring those to Jesus and be honest with Him. Let Jesus heal your cravings and lack with true fulfillment.
