- Why is simply "stopping" a sinful habit not enough to create lasting change?
- What does it look like to intentionally "replace evil with good" in a practical way?
- Which area of your life currently needs a "put off / put on" change?
- How does community help us walk in wholehearted obedience?
- What one specific step of obedience can you take this week to close the gap between what you say and how you live?

# **CHALLENGE**

Our challenge is a question: From which evil do you need to turn away, and turn your attention back to the Lord? Name it, bring it before God, and replace it with an act of obedience. Don't generalize it. Don't excuse it. Name it. Turn from it. Replace it.
