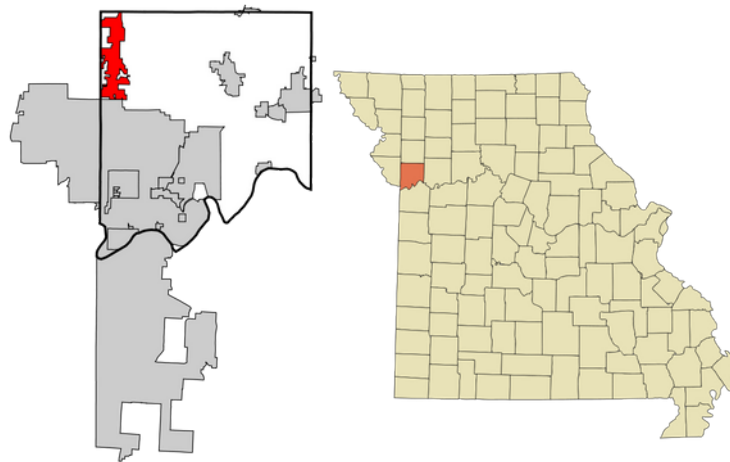

DID YOU KNOW?

- √ The population of Smithville, Missouri is 10,249 (2018)
- √ There are 19.85 miles from Smithville to Kansas City in south direction and 21 miles (33.80 kilometers) by car, following the US-169 route. Smithville and Kansas City are 24 minutes far apart, if you drive non-stop.
- √ The Smithville Dam was authorized in 1965. Construction began in 1972 with the dam being completed in 1977. Impoundment began in 1979.
- √ Smithville's Lake has 5,000 acres (20 km²) of public land and 175 miles (282 km) of shoreline.
