HELPFUL TIPS

Here are a few tips to help everything go smoothly and make your detail photos truly stand out!

FLOWER DELIVERY

Arrange for the bouquets, boutonnières, and loose florals to be delivered to your getting-ready location 30 minutes before my scheduled arrival. This will ensure everything is ready for me when I get there!

CALLIGRAPHY

If you have calligraphy or special lettering on your invitations, please get an extra copy made for me to photograph. You can use a placeholder address or even the address of your venue!

ALL THREE RINGS

Make sure to include all three rings (engagement ring, bride's band, groom's band) with your details so I can photograph them together. Once I'm finished, we can hand the bands over to whoever is responsible for keeping them safe!





FULL INVITE SUITE

Be sure to include all the envelopes with your invitation suite so I can capture the complete design. Feel free to add your Save the Date as well!

DUPLICATE INVITES

If any parts of your invitation suite are double-sided, please provide two copies so both sides can be photographed in a single shot. Also, consider including both blank and addressed envelopes to give me more styling options!





DELEGATE

The key to a stress-free wedding day is delegating tasks! Assign a bridesmaid to manage the detail items and ensure they are handed over to me when I arrive, so you don't have to worry about it.

COORDINATING PAPER

If you have any additional paper items that match your invitation suite, feel free to include those as well! This could be menus, table numbers, place cards, vow books, and more.





GROOM'S DETAILS

You can also include any special groom details you'd like photographed, such as cufflinks, ties, shoes, tie clips, and more.
